THE MATCHUP

Hofstra travels to Williamsburg, Virginia, to complete a weekend road trip and wrap up the season series with William & Mary. Hofstra picked up a 65-54 win over the Tribe on January 19.

THE SERIES

Hofstra holds a 29-10-1 advantage in the all-time series with William & Mary.

LAST TIME THEY MET

Senior Aleana Leon scored a game-high 19 points to lead four Pride players in doublefigures as Hofstra defeated William and Mary, 65-54, on January 19. Leon hit eightof-18 shots from the field and was two-fortwo from the line for her game high points. Senior Ashunae Durant recorded her sixth double-double of the season and third straight, with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Junior Boogie Brozoski added 12 points, six rebounds and six assists while sophomore Marianne Kalin chipped in with 11 points and eight caroms. William & Mary was led by junior Bianca Boggs and sophomore Victoria Reynolds with 15 points each.

QUICK HITS

- · Hofstra has won four of its last seven games.
- Mikiyah Croskey made her first career start in place of an injured Ashunae Durant and had season highs of 18 points and six rebounds at James Madison Friday night.

CAA PRESEASON POLL

- Hofstra Women's Basketball was predicted to finish seventh in the CAA in the league's preseason poll.
- The Pride finished 5-13 in conference last season, good for the No. 8 seed in the CAA Championship.

PRESEASON ALL-CAA

- Senior Ashunae Durant was named to the Preseason All-CAA First Team for the second consecutive season after earning second-team honors at the conclusion of last season.
- Classmate Aleana Leon was an honorable mention.

200 WINS

- Hofstra Head Coach Krista Kilburn-Steveskey recorded her 200th career win on Feb. 14, 2018, with a 65-60 victory over Charleston.
- Already the winningest coach in program history after surpassing Harvey Pyser's 162 victories, Kilburn-Steveskey became the first to post 200 wins and is now 201-166.

LET'S BOOGIE

- Since becoming eligible on Dec. 21, junior Boogie Brozoski is averaging 10.2 points and 4.8 assists per game.
- Since joining the starting lineup on Jan. 5 at Charleston, she is averaging 11.9 points per game.
- She posted her first career double-double at Charleston, finishing with 16 points and 10 assists.

ON THE DEFENSIVE

- The Pride has allowed just one of its CAA opponents to score more than 61 points in a game (73 by JMU on January 26).
- Hofstra is allowing just 58.4 points per game in CAA play.

ASKIN FOR TROUBLE

- Senior Olivia Askin has scored in double figures seven times this season, after only reaching the mark once before.
- She has scored a career-high 18 points on three occasions, including going 6-for-6 from three-point range on Jan. 5 at Charleston.
- After going 5-for-5 from three-point range on Jan. 14, Askin went 11-for-11 against Charleston this season.

DURANT DOUBLING UP

- Senior Ashunae Durant has posted six double-doubles this season.
- She leads the team with 12 games in double figures and six games in double-digit rebounds.

LEON LIGHTING IT UP

- Senior Aleana Leon posted the first double-double of her career on Nov. 30 at Sacred Heart, finishing with 12 points and 12 rebounds.
- She put together a streak of six straight games in double figures, the longest such streak of her career, between November 14 and Decmber 4.

DAVIS'S DAY

- Sophomore E'Lexus Davis neared a triple-double in the season opener against UMBC with 17 points, eight rebounds and nine assists.
- Serving as the starting point guard for the first half of the season, Davis was averaging in double figures when she had a starting role.
- · Davis leads the Pride with 60 assists.

CALLING ON KALIN

- Sophomore Marianne Kalin posted her first career double-double on Dec. 7 at Iona, finishing with 25 points and 11 rebounds.
- She has scored in double figures five times this season, after only accomplishing the feat twice as a freshman.

MCCLAIN WATCH LIST

- Senior forward Ashunae Durant has been named to the Katrina McClain preseason watch list.
- The inaugural Katrina McClain Award will honor the best power forward in women's college basketball.
- The award will be presented at the NCAA Women's Final Four in Columbus.

1,000 POINT CLUB

- Senior forward Ashunae Durant recorded her 1,000th career point on Jan. 29, 2017 against Elon, finishing with 17 points on the day.
- She became the 24th player in Hofstra Women's Basketball history to reach the milestone and just the 12th do so in three seasons or less.

CLOSE QUARTERS

- So far this season, 11 of the Pride's games have seen a margin of six points or fewer at halftime, with four being a differential of just one point at the break.
- Hofstra has gone on to win seven of those games, with four of the victories coming by six points or fewer.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

- Hofstra has been notoriously strong at the David S. Mack Sports and Exhibition Complex. The Pride was an even 7-7 at home last season.
- Since the 2008-09 campaign, the Pride has gone 90-48 at home.

GOLD STANDARD

- Hofstra is currently 6-2 in its gold uniforms in 2017-18, with its only losses coming to CAA preseason favorite James Madison and Drexel.
- Last season, Hofstra was 5-1 when wearing gold, with the only loss coming in the CAA Quarterfinals to eventual champion Elon.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

- This year's Hofstra Women's Basketball team has eight nationalities represented, including four sophomores that come to Hempstead from overseas.
- The sophomore class features two student-athletes from Finland (Marianne Kalin and Sandra Karsten), one from the Canary Islands (Ana Hernandez Gil) and one from Slovenia (Petja Krupenko).
- Joining them this season is freshman Mie Hoff from Norway and Sica Cuzic, a junior transfer from Romania.

CAA WEEKLY AWARDS

• Junior Boogie Brozoski earned the Pride's first CAA weekly award of the season - and the first of her career - on Jan. 8, after posting a pair of career performances in two road wins for Hofstra. She posted her first career double-double (16 points, 10 rebounds) in a win at Charleston before putting up a personal-best 18 points - all in the pivotal second half - in a victory at UNCW.

KRISTA KILBURN-STEVESKEY

Krista Kilburn-Steveskey is in her 12th season as Hofstra's head coach in 2017-18. She has averaged over 17 wins per season since arriving on campus in 2006 while posting seven winning seasons and leading the Pride to five appearances in the Women's National Invitation Tournament, including two consecutive appearances in 2014-15 and 2015-16. With a 201-166 career record, Kilburn-Steveskey is the winningest coach in Pride history and her .548 winning percentage is third all-time.

Kilburn-Steveskey, who was named the 11th head women's basketball coach at Hofstra University on May 16, 2006, led the Pride to the WNIT in 2007, 2010, 2012, 2015 and 2016, with trips to the quarterfinals in 2007 and 2016 and a second round visit in 2010. She also steered Hofstra to a team Division I-record 26 victories in 2006-07. She signed a multi-year contract extension in October 2013.

In 2016-2017, Kilburn-Steveskey led the Pride back to the Colonial Athletic Association quarterfinals, and helped forward Ashunae Durant earn All-CAA and All-Met Second-Team honors. Durant recorded her 1,000th career point, becoming the 12th player in program history to reach the milestone in three seasons or less. Krystal Luciano also joined the 1,000 point club in her final season in Hempstead, while also recording the program's first triple-double, posting 21 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a win over UNCW on Jan. 15. Luciano became just the fifth player in CAA history to post 1,000 career points, 500 assists and 400 rebounds.

Kilburn-Steveskey is a 1990 graduate of North Carolina State University in Raleigh, North Carolina, where she was coached by the legendary Yow and served as team captain during her senior year. In her four years at NC State, the Wolfpack compiled an 83-37 record and advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 in 1987, 1989 and 1990. The 1990 squad posted a 25-6 record, won the regular season ACC championship and was ranked 11th in the nation by the *Associated Press*.
