TRIBE BY THE NUMBERS

10	W&M has won a school-record 10 road games already this season. The 10 road wins are tied for second in the nation behind UConn's 11 victories.
16.8	Tonight the top two assists teams in the CAA square off. W&M holds a slight advantage at 16.8 assists per game over Drexel (16.5). The 16.8 apg. ranks 19th in the nation.
69	Seniors Victoria Reynolds and Ashley Taylor are now the winningest class in school history with 69 career wins.
70	70 seems to be a magic number under Swanson. W&M has reached that mark 62 times under Swanson, and has posted a 51-11 when accomplishing that feat.
80.9%	W&M leads the nation in free-throw percentage at 80.9%. The Tribe has connected on 327-of-404 from the line.
91.5%	Eva Hodgson ranks fourth in the NCAA at 91.5% from the line. She has hit 138-of-151 from the free-throw line.
481	Hodgson currently ranks 7th in single-season school history with 481 points. With her average (20.0 ppg.) today she would move into fourth place.
1,155	Senior Victoria Reynolds is now tied for 14th in school history with 1,155 points. She needs 62 more points to move into sole possession of 13th all-time.

W&M NEWS & NOTES

- The William & Mary women's basketball team puts its five-game winning streak on the line as it travels to Drexel, which has won 11 in a row and is in first place in the CAA, on Friday, Feb. 21. Tip time between the Tribe and the Dragons is set for 7 p.m.
- W&M and Drexel meet for the 45th time in series history on Friday night. Drexel leads the series 28-16 and has won the last two games, including a 61-54 triumph in Williamsburg on Jan. 26. In that game, senior Victoria Reynolds recorded a double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds, while sophomore Eva Hodgson finished with 12. Drexel's Niki Metzel led all scorers with 16 points, while Bailey Greenberg had 12 and Aubree Brown finished with 10.
- The Tribe's five-game winning streak is the longest winning streak since a seven-game winning streak that stretched from Nov. 21 to Dec. 17, 2017. Since that winning streak, W&M has had five three-game winning streaks before the current five-game spurt. The five consecutive CAA wins are tied for the most consecutive wins in a CAA season. W&M also won five straight league games from Feb. 10 to Feb. 24, 2006.
- The Green and Gold's 18 wins are already the fourth best single-season mark in school history. W&M has a pair of 20 win seasons in 1993-94 and 2016-17 and also won 19 games during the 2006-07 season.
- For the fifth time this season and the third time in the last six games, W&M hit the 80-point mark in its win over Northeastern last Friday. In its wins over Elon and Charleston, the Tribe scored 80 in back-to-back games for the first time since Dec. 2 and Dec. 5, 2017. The Green and Gold is now 21-2 when reaching the mark under head coach Ed Swanson.
- Sophomore Eva Hodgson was named the CAA Player of the Week for the week of Feb. 10. The sophomore had previously been named honorable mention player of the week twice this season. W&M has been honored seven times this year by the CAA as senior Victoria Reynolds was player of the week for the week of Dec. 9, while freshman Bre Bellamy has been named the rookie of the week three times. Additionally, Hodgson was named to the @NCAAWBB Starting Five team of the week for the week of Feb. 3.
- Hodgson has come alive during the Tribe's five-game winning streak as she has averaged 23.0 points per game in the five victories. She became just the ninth player in school history with multiple 30-point performances in the same season and is just the second player in school history with back-to-back 30-point games. Hodgson joins Taysha Pye as the only other woman in W&M lore to score two 30-point games in her first two years. Now with 12 20-point games, is in third in school history for 20-point games in a single-season.
- Furthermore, Hodgson has been the Tribe's leading scorer in all but four games. After scoring the most points in the Division I era in a season opener (27), Hodgson then scored the most points in W&M's DI era when she scored career-high 34 points at Elon. She is averaging 20.0 points per game, 3.6 rebounds, and 3.9 assists. She leads the conference with 20.0 points per game (11th in the NCAA), 55.3% from the field (26th in the NCAA), and 90.9% (fourth in the NCAA). She has been in double-figures in 23 of the Tribe's 24 games this season.
- This month, the William & Mary women's basketball team will be participating in the Play4Kay National Free Throw Challenge with all of their CAA conference mates. Fans can make a donation or a one-time pledge for each Tribe free throw during February. More info is available on TribeAthletics.com.
- Another key to the Tribe's success this season is getting at least three players in double-figures. W&M has posted a perfect 13-0 mark when three players reach the double-figure plateau, including the win against Northeastern on Feb. 14.
- For the ninth time in under head coach Ed Swanson W&M shot better than 55% in a contest when it shot 58% against Charleston in January. The Tribe's 58.3% field goal percentage at VCU, the season-high, ranks tied for seventh under Swanson and is the seventh-best in school history. For the season, the Tribe is shooting 45.0%, which is tops in the CAA and ranks 25th nationally.
- Senior Victoria Reynolds has been turning it on since the George Washington game. She has been in double-figures in the 13 of the last 14 contests and is averaging 16.7 points per game during that stretch and has two double-doubles as well. A Preseason All-CAA Honorable Mention selection, Reynolds is second on the team averaging 15.3 points per game (seventh in the CAA) and leads the team with 6.3 rebounds a night. She has been in double-figures in 58 career games and has scored 1,155 career points.
- Junior Bailey Eichner has enjoyed her enhanced role during her junior campaign and earned four straight starts from Jan. 24 to Feb. 7. Earlier this season, she scored a career-high 11 points in the win at East Carolina, before adding a career-high nine rebounds at George Washington. The Cudahy, Wisc. is averaging 3.5 points, 5.4 rebounds, 1.0 assists, 1.0 steals, and 0.7 blocks per game. More impressively, Eichner is averaging 12.2 rebounds per 40-minute game.
- Sophomore Sydney Wagner has also provided valuable depth for the Tribe all season long, but especially in the five-game winning streak. During the win streak, Wagner is averaging 10.0 points per game and is averaging 9.1 points per game in league action. For the season, the redshirt sophomore is averaging 8.5 points a night, and hitting 32.3% from range.
- Usually tasked with guarding the opponent's best offensive threat, junior Nyla Pollard has had a breakout year on the offensive end of the floor. On Feb. 14, the junior tied a career-high with 14 points in the win over Northeastern and is averaging 6.7 ppg., including 8.4 in the last five, in CAA play. For the year, she is averaging a career-high 6.1 ppg., 2.2 rpg., and 3.8 apg.
- W&M head coach Ed Swanson became the 69th head coach in Division I history to win his 500th career game against Hartford on Nov. 23, before becoming just the third W&M coach to win 100 career games with the Tribe against Charleston last month. To continue a milestone-driven season for Swanson, he was announced as an inductee to the Northeast Conference Hall of Fame in late January. Now at 513 wins, Swanson ranks as the 31st active head coach in the country in terms of wins, and with 107 wins as head coach of the Tribe he is third all-time and is 40 away from all-time wins leader Debbie Taylor.

Ed Swanson enters his sixth season with the Green and Gold. He became the fifth Division I head women's basketball coach in William and Mary history on May 7, 2013. Prior to coming to Williamsburg, he spent 23 years transforming Sacred Heart University from a Division II program into one of the top teams in the Northeast Conference. Swanson owns a career record of 495-356 (.582).

For the fifth straight season, a first in W&M history, the Tribe won 15 games and advanced to the CAA Quarterfinals in the 2018-19 season. Senior Bianca Boggs continued her assault on the W&M record books as she finished her career with 1,455 points, which ranks sixth in school history, while her single-season 530 points was a new school record. For her efforts she was named to the All-CAA First-Team for the second straight season. Swanson also guided freshman Eva Hodgson to CAA Rookie of the Year honors, making her the second player in his time at W&M to win the award. Hodgson finished the season averaging 10.2 points and 3.0 assists per contest. The senior class - Boggs, Misha Jones, and Chandler Smith - tied the school record for winningest senior class with 66 victories.

The success continued for the Tribe during the 2017-18 season. W&M won 16 games, which is tied for the fourth most in school history, and posted its second straight winning season for the first time since 2005-06 and 2006-07. His first recruiting class became the winningest class in school history with the team's victory over College of Charleston on Jan. 26. The seniors went onto win 66 games during their four year career. The Tribe raced out to an 11-2 start for the third straight season, which equaled the best 13-game start in school history, and led the CAA in blocked shots (218) and blocked shots per game (7.3), which ranked fourth and third in the NCAA, respectively. Both numbers are single-season school records. Individually, he mentored three players to five All-CAA awards, including All-CAA First-Team selection Bianca Boggs, who became the first Tribe player in a decade to be named to the league's first-team. Additionally, Boggs was named to the league's all-defensive team, while Abby Rendle claimed a spot on the All-CAA Third-Team, and All-Defensive Team, and freshman Nyla Pollard was picked to the CAA All-Rookie team.

Swanson led the Tribe to one of its best seasons in program history in 2016-17. The Tribe tied a school record with 20 wins, while winning a CAA Tournament game for the first time since 2009, and advancing to the CAA Semifinals for the first-time since 2001. Under his leadership, the Tribe won 11-straight games, which is the longest single-season streak in school history, from Nov. 18, 2016-Jan. 2, 2017. W&M had four players claim seven all-conference awards this season, including seniors Alexandra Masaquel and Marlena Tremba, who each earned second-team citations. Additionally, Masaquel was tabbed the Richmond Times-Dispatch All-State Second-Team, while Tremba earned VaSID All-State Second-Team honors. For his efforts, VaSID honored him as the Virginia State Coach of the Year.

Once again Swanson's third season was one for the record books. The Tribe raced out to its best start in school history with an 11-2 record. W&M went onto again to win the fourth most wins in school history with 15. For the second straight season the Tribe broke the blocks and assist record, by tying the single season assist record (466) and broke the school record for blocks with 148. During the season junior Marlena Tremba became the 15th player in school history to break the 1000-point barrier. Individually, four players earned All-CAA awards as junior Alexandra Masaquel was tabbed to the second-team and all-defensive team, Tremba earned third-team honors, and freshman Bianca Boggs picked up a spot on the all-rookie team. The Tribe was also rewarded for its hard work in the classroom as Masaquel, Tremba, and sophomore Jenna Green earned all-academic team honors.

Swanson's second year with the Green and Gold was one for the record books. The Tribe racked up 15 wins, the fourth-most in school history, on its way to its first-ever postseason appearances with bid in the Women's Basketball Invitational. The Green and Gold had a seven-win turnaround, while setting three school records for assists (466), blocked shots, (143), blocked shots per game (4.5). Individually he helped lead four players to five All-CAA awards. Sophomore Marlena Tremba was named to the All-CAA Third-Team, senior Jazmen Boone was named to the All-Defensive Team, freshman Abby Rendle to the All-Rookie and All-Defensive team, and senior Kyla Kerstetter earned all-academic honors.

In his first season with the Tribe, Swanson led a young team to eight victories in a seven-seed in the CAA Tournament. The Green and Gold finished in the top 10 nationally in steals per game, while Jazmen Boone also ranked in the top 20 in the NCAA in the same category. Under his



guidance Kaitlyn Mathieu garnered Third-Team All-Colonial Athletic Association honors, and went on to sign a professional contract with a team in Germany. In addition, guard Marlena Tremba went onto win CAA Rookie of the Year, and was named to the all-rookie squad. Boone was named to the all-defensive team, while she and Kyla Kerstetter took home all-academic honors.

Swanson oversaw Sacred Heart's transition from Division II to Division I in 1999-00, and the program took off under his direction. Over Sacred Heart's 14 years in Division I, Swanson led SHU to a 280-145 record (.664), including a 190-62 (.754) record in the NEC. He departed as the NEC's all-time winningest head coach with all of his SHU teams finishing third or higher in the league standings. Swanson-lead teams have posted 13 straight winning seasons and 12 straight campaigns with 18 or more victories, including six with 20 or more wins. In 2009, he was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame.

In total, Swanson-coached players earned 19 All-NEC honors, including nine first-team awards, nine NEC All-Tournament Team honors, eight NEC All-Rookie Team selections, four NEC Rookies of the Year, three NEC Tournament MVPs and three NEC Players of the Year.

His teams have also enjoyed success in the classroom. On five occasions, the Pioneers were selected to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll, which has recognized outstanding academic performances from the top teams in each of the five collegiate divisions since 1995-96. On eight occasions since 2003, one of his players was a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection and two Pioneer players were named NEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

In 2012-13, Swanson led Sacred Heart to its third straight postseason appearance, and in the process, recorded his 400th career victory. His milestone win came on Feb. 12, 2013 as the Pioneers defeated Fairleigh Dickinson. SHU completed the season at 22-11, finishing second in the NEC with a 13-5 ledger and garnering a berth in the program's first Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT).

Sacred Heart claimed its third NEC Championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2011-12. The Pioneers also ranked 23rd nationally in the WBCA Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll with a team GPA of 3.35. SHU compiled a season mark to 25-8, winning both the regular season and postseason crowns in the league as Swanson was named NEC Coach of the Year for the fourth time.

The Pioneers earned a berth in the 2011 Women's Basketball Invitational and finished the year at 18-13 with a 12-6 mark in the NEC. After a 0-5 start to the 2008-09 season, Swanson's Pioneers reeled off a 21-game winning streak, the longest in school history and second longest in the country, before finishing with 25-8 record. SHU completed the NEC regular season with a perfect 18-0 mark, becoming just the third team in the history of the conference to accomplish the feat. Swanson earned NEC Coach of the Year honors as Sacred Heart finished off an amazing season by capturing its second league title and trip to the NCAA Tournament over a four-year span. During the 2008-09 season, Swanson moved past former Mount St. Mary's head coach Bill Sheahan (124) as all-time leader in Northeast Conference wins and eclipsing the 300-win plateau in his career.

The 2005-06 season saw Swanson lead the Sacred Heart program to its first NCAA Tournament, capturing the NEC Championship in just its seventh season at the Division I level. Swanson guided the Pioneers to a school record 26-5 record, including a 16-2 NEC ledger. He also garnered career victory No. 250 during the season.

Under his leadership, Sacred Heart was one of the toughest teams on its home court, the William H. Pitt Center, which opened in 1997. During the Pitt Center's opening 16 seasons, Swanson's teams won 81.9 percent (185-41) of its home games. In 2011-12, SHU went 15-1 at home, a season bested only by a perfect 15-0 in 2005-06 and 14-0 in 2003-04. During the stretch, the Pioneers' home winning percentage at the Pitt Center ranked among the best nationally.

After directing the Pioneers to a 20-7 record – the program's first 20-win season – in 1995-96, Swanson was voted Coach of the Year in the New England Collegiate Conference (NECC) and the Women's Basketball

Swanson took the reins of the Sacred Heart University women's basketball program in 1990 and built the Pioneers into one of the top teams in the Northeast. He joined Dave Bike's men's basketball coaching staff at SHU in 1989, and, after becoming head coach of the Pioneer women's program in 1990, did double duty for three seasons before becoming the University's first full-time women's coach in 1993. Prior to Swanson's arrival, the Sacred Heart women's team compiled a 4-21 record. Under his guidance, the climb to Division II respectability was accomplished within three seasons, from 8-19 to 11-16 and, in 1992-93, to 16-13 – the program's first winning record in 11 seasons.

In his time at SHU, he was a four-time NEC Coach of the Year, led Sacred Heart to five postseason bids, including three NCAA Tournament appearances. Swanson guided the Pioneers to four NEC regular season crowns and three NEC tournament championships. SHU posted 20-win seasons seven times during his tenure, including five of the last eight years.

He earned a bachelor's degree in business from Sacred Heart in 1989. Also during his tenure at SHU, Swanson served as the moderator for the Pioneer Student-Athlete Council from 1998-01 and was the annual coordinator of commencement exercises since 2000. Swanson and his wife, Marion, have two sons, Connor and Matthew.
