## W&amp;M NEWS AND NOTES

• The William & Mary baseball team looks to get back in the win column as it plays a pair of mid-week road games at Atlantic 10 opponents this week. The Tribe travels to George Mason on Tuesday, April 23, before heading to Richmond on Wednesday, April 24. Both contests carry 3 p.m. first pitches.

• W&M and George Mason play for the 96th time in series history on Tuesday afternoon. Mason leads the all-time series 61-34, but it will be the first meeting since 2017. The Tribe has won the last two in the series, including a 4-2 win in the visit to Fairfax on April 26, 2017. Senior Owen Socher went 2-for-5 with a run scored and RBI in the victory.

• The Tribe will then meet Richmond for the 159th time in series history and the first time since 2017 on Wednesday afternoon. The Spiders lead the all-time series of former CAA foes 103-54. However, W&M has won the last two games, including an 11-10 triumph at Pitt Field on April 2017. Now seniors Owen Socher and Kyle Wright led the Tribe in that game. Socher went 3-for-6 with two runs scored and an RBI, while Wright added two hits.

• This week, the Tribe will play games four and five of six scheduled games against Atlantic 10 opponents. The Tribe is currently 2-1 against the A-10 with a win over VCU and splitting the series with George Washington. The Tribe travels to Saint Joseph's for its final game against the A-10 the last week of the regular season.

• Senior Owen Socher led the Tribe last weekend against Elon going 4-for-10 with two doubles and his first homer of the season. He drove in two runs, while scoring three of his own. Since starting 15 of the last 17 games, Socher is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with five double, two triples, a homer, five RBI, and 13 runs scored.

• The Green and Gold played its first extra-inning game of the season on April 20 in the first game against Elon. The Tribe fell in the contest 11-9 in 10 innings in its first extra inning game since May of 2018. Head coach Brian Murphy is 11-13 in extra-inning games in his Tribe career.

• The Tribe had its first walk off of the season in its 2-1 triumph of the season against George Washington Wednesday night at Plumeri. It was the first walk-off for the Tribe since March 18, 2018, against East Tennessee State. The Tribe now has 13 walk-off wins under Brian Murphy.

• W&M's 2-1 victory against George Washington was its 10th one-run game of the season. The Tribe is 6-4 in those contests this season, and the win snapped a three-game losing streak in those ball games.

• Following his complete game against James Madison on April 12, junior Wade Strain was named the CAA Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 15. The righty allowed one run on three hits with a career-high seven strikeouts. He also retired 16 Dukes in a row from the fourth to the ninth. The award gives W&M five weekly awards as Matt McDermott has been named the CAA Rookie of the Week and freshmen Zach Tsakounis (twice) and Tristan Snyder have been named Rookie of the Week.

• W&M turned double plays in the third and eighth innings at George Washington (April 10) marking the eighth time this season the Tribe recorded multiple double plays in a game. For the season, the Tribe pitching staff and defense has turned 31 double plays, which ranks second in the CAA and 50th nationally.



• Senior Bodie Sheehan has been one of the Tribe's all-time most consistent pitchers during his career. The senior has turned three of his best starts the last four times out, getting into the seventh inning each time. He has recorded six quality starts in his 10 starts this season. The Virginia Beach, Va. native has now made 54 starts and will break the school record on Saturday afternoon at Towson. Sheehan also became the seventh W&M pitcher to surpass 300 career innings and the 13th to eclipse 200 career strikeouts.

• Redshirt junior Chris Farrell has been one of the sharpest arms out of the Tribe bullpen this season. Farrell owns a 2.01 ERA while throwing 22.1 innings with 33 strikeouts against just 13 walks. The redshirt junior leads the team with four saves.

• On the offensive end, the Tribe is fourth in the CAA with 229 runs scored. The team has put at least eight runs on the scoreboard in 12 games, going 10-2. W&M ranks 50th in the NCAA with 77 doubles, while its 17 triples are good for 10th in the NCAA.

• Senior Hunter Smith became the 20th player in school history to record 200 career hits in the doubleheader on Saturday against Elon. The senior ranks second in the CAA with 10 homers, while his 26 career bombs are good for a tie for ninth in W&M history.

• Classmate Zach Pearson is enjoying a strong close to his Tribe career. He leads the team and ranks seventh in the CAA with a .319 batting average this year. The senior also leads the team in multi-hit games with 13, including one in the series finale against Elon. Pearson has added 12 doubles, two triples, and 24 RBI.

• Plumeri Park, the home of the Tribe Baseball, turns 20 this spring. The anniversary will be celebrated and recognized over the course of the season. The facility was constructed in large part due to the generous donation by Mr. Joseph J. Plumeri II in the autumn of 1996. It is now considered one of the finest baseball facilities in the region, consistently receiving upgrades over the course of time. W&M has enjoyed a lot of success at Plumeri Park with a 391-204 (.657) since its completion.

Brian Murphy was named head coach of the Tribe baseball program on Dec. 3, 2013, and enters his sixth season as the Tribe's head coach. It will be his seventh season in Williamsburg, after spending one season as the Tribe's top assistant coach.

The former one-year assistant guided the Green and Gold to three 30-plus win seasons, a NCAA Regional Final appearances and a Colonial Athletic Association Tournament bid each season in his first four years as the skipper. Before his promotion, Murphy helped the Tribe earn its first-ever NCAA Tournament at-large bid and win its first regional games in school history on the strength of a record-setting 39-win season in 2013. He made a seamless transition to head coach the following year as W&M secured its first-ever regular season conference title, culminating in CAA Coach of the Year honors. A couple seasons later, W&M captured its first CAA tournament championship since 2001 en route to reaching the NCAA Regional Final for the second time in a four-year span.

In 2017, a third-place finish in the CAA standings allowed W&M to make its fifth consecutive postseason appearance, which is a program-best since qualifying started for the CAA Baseball Tournament. Murphy secured his 100th career victory mid-way through the season after the Tribe edged conference rival UNCW, 10-9, on March 26. At the end of the regular season, the Green and Gold landed five players on the all-conference teams, highlighted by junior Cullen Large receiving All-CAA First Team accolades. Senior Ryder Miconi, who was tabbed All-CAA Third Team, continued to excel in the classroom as he repeated as CAA Scholar Athlete of the Year. In addition, All-CAA second teamer Brandon Raquet was named to Collegiate Baseball's Freshman All-American Team. Murphy also helped produced a draft class of at least three W&M players for the fifth time in program history. Redshirt sophomore Nick Raquet became the third-highest all-time MLB draft pick by getting selected in the third round by the Washington Nationals. Large was chosen in the fifth round by the Toronto Blue Jays and senior Nick Brown was picked by the Minnesota Twins in the 32nd round. It was the second time in program history that two players were taken inside the first five rounds of the MLB Draft.

The 2016 season will go down as one of the most memorable seasons in program history. Down 8-1 in what looked like its final at-bat of the season, the Tribe answered with seven runs in the ninth and sparked a two-week run for the ages. Following a 27-hour rain delay, W&M went onto win the first CAA Championship game in 12 innings, before senior Josh Smith's grand-slam homer in the bottom of the eighth inning lifted them to the CAA Tournament crown and automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. In the NCAA Regional, the Tribe, which fell in its first game, knocked out Bryant and defending national champion Virginia on its way to its second Regional Final in four seasons. When all was said and done the Green and Gold won six elimination games against Northeastern, College of Charleston, UNCW (twice), Bryant, and Virginia. For his efforts, Murphy was named VaSID Coach of the Year. Individually, he helped lead six Tribe players to all-conference awards, including senior Charley Gould, 23732junior Ryder Miconi, and sophomore Ryan Hall, who were named to the second team. Miconi was rewarded for his hard work in the classroom by being named the CAA Scholar Athlete of the Year. Gould became the 35th player in school history to be drafted when the Oakland Athletics drafted him in the 26th round. It was the fifth straight season that the Tribe had a player selected in the MLB Draft.

Throughout his stint in the W&M dugout, Murphy has mentored a total of nine MLB Draft picks, two national award semifinalists and 23 all-conference players. Michael Katz (2012-14), who garnered multiple All-American honors, was tabbed a Golden Spikes Award semifinalist in 2014. Additionally, Katz and Charley Gould (2013-16) were just two of three players in program history to become Dick Hower Trophy semifinalists, representing W&M on the prestigious list in back-to-back years ('14 & '15). Murphy also helped develop a plethora of record-setting athletes. Under his watch, four pitching records were shattered as John Farrell (2010-13) set a new single-season wins standard (11), Jason Inghram (2012-15) replaced the school's all-time wins mark (26), Joseph Gaouette (2013-16) broke the career saves record (18), and Charlie Fletcher became the all-time appearance leader (105). Additionally, Katz eclipsed the single-season RBI ledger (75), while Ryan Hall raised the bar for most career at bats (844).

The Easton Mass. native, who enters his sixth season with the Tribe baseball program, after spending three-seasons at Ivy League school Brown.

While at Brown, Murphy served as the Bears recruiting coordinator and hitting coach. During his three-year tenure in Providence, R.I., Murphy mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections.

Prior to his time with the Bears, Murphy was an assistant at Bryant University in Smithfield, R.I., (2006-09) where he was the recruiting director for the Bulldogs. His on the field responsibilities at Bryant included overseeing the catchers, outfielders and batting. In 2008, he was a member of a Bulldog squad that captured the Northeast-10 Championship. His tenure at Bryant was highlighted by 132 victories, two NCAA Tournament Regional final appearances and a school-record 42 wins in 2008. At the plate, Bryant improved every season in batting average and runs per game under Murphy's tutelage.

In 2004 and 2005, Murphy served as an assistant at Wheaton College in Norton, Ma. While coaching at Wheaton, Murphy's coaching engagement centered on the Lyons' hitting approach and catchers. The Lyons captured two New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) titles and made it all the way to the 2005 NCAA New England Regional finals during Murphy's two seasons.

Murphy has summer coaching experience in the Cape Cod League and the Northwoods League. Murphy served as the hitting coach for the CCBL's Hyannis Mets during the summers of 2005 and 2006. In 2008, he was the Head Coach of the Battle Creek (MI) Bombers of the Northwoods League.

He played collegiately at Merrimack College in North Andover, Mass., where he was the team captain in 2003. Murphy earned a degree in business management from Merrimack in 2003 and a Master's Degree in Sports Management from California University of Pennsylvania in 2009.

Murphy resides in Williamsburg with his wife, Karen, son, Connor, and daughter Maggie.
