## W&amp;M NEWS AND NOTES

• The William & Mary baseball team concludes the regular season at travels to Hofstra for a crucial three-game Colonial Athletic Association series on Friday, May 17 and Saturday, May 18.

• W&M and Hofstra meet for the 43rd through the 45th time on Friday and Saturday. The Tribe leads all-time series with Pride 27-15, but Hofstra won all three games in Williamsburg a season ago. Senior Colin Lipke led the Tribe going 3-for-6 with two RBI in two games, while junior Brandon Raquet added three RBI over the weekend.

• Both senior Hunter Smith and Brandon Raquet were honored for their work in the classroom as the duo was tabbed to the CoSIDA Google Cloud Academic All-District Team on May 9. Smith graduated with his degree in kinesiology and health sciences, while Raquet his nearing his degree in neuroscience and is on a pre-med track.

• With one more win this season, W&M will win 30 games for the 11th time in program history. It will also be the fifth time in the last seven seasons, the Tribe has surpassed the 30 win mark in the season.

• W&M won its sixth CAA weekly award of the season as junior Brandon Raquet was named the CAA Player of the Week on May 6. Raquet led the Tribe to a sweep of Charleston by hitting .583 with two homers, four RBI, and four runs scored. He joins classmate Wade Strain, who was CAA Pitcher of the Week, sophomore Matthew McDermott (CAA Player of the Week) and freshmen Tristan Snyder and Zach Tsakounis (twice), who won CAA Rookie of the Week, to garner a CAA weekly award.

• Senior Owen Socher has seemed to have a knack for being hit by a pitch throughout his Tribe career and even more so this season. The senior ranks 20th in the NCAA reaching base by 15 HBPs this season. He currently ranks ninth in single-season school history, while his 30 career HBPs rank him sixth in school history.

• The Tribe has had its most success offensively in the second inning of games this year. W&M has outscored its opponents 50-11 in the second frame.

• W&M stole four bases in the win at George Mason on April 24. The four stolen bases were the second most this season behind five bags swiped against Campbell on March 8. Senior Zach Pearson tied a career-high with two steals in the game. For the season, W&M has swiped 50 bags.

• Socher has made the most of his recent opportunity, since starting 24 of the last 26 games, The senior has added 18 hits, six doubles, two triples, a homer, six RBI, and 18 runs scored. His 18 runs scored are the most on the team in that time.

• The Green and Gold played a pair of extra inning contests to complete the series sweep of Charleston. W&M picked up a 4-3 win in 13 innings in the second game, before a 4-3 triumph in the finale to improve its record



to 2-1 in extra frames this season. Head coach Brian Murphy is 13-13 in extra-inning games in his Tribe career.

- The Tribe recorded three walk-off wins during the home portion of its regular season schedule. The Green and Gold had a walk-off error against George Washington, before sophomore Matt McDermott and freshman Jack Cone had walk-off doubles on back-to-back days in the Charleston series. The Tribe now has 15 walk-off wins under Brian Murphy.

- W&M's has played 14 one-run games of the season. The Tribe is 9-5 in those contests this season, including winning its last three one-run games.

- The Tribe turned nine double plays in the series against Charleston the last time out. For the year, the Tribe pitching staff and defense has turned 48 double plays, which ranks second in the CAA and 16th nationally. W&M's 1.0 double plays per game rank ninth in the country.

- Senior Bodie Sheehan has been one of the Tribe's all-time most consistent pitchers during his career. The senior has turned five of his best starts of the year the last six times out, getting into the seventh inning each time. He has recorded eight quality starts in his 12 starts this season, and has not allowed an earned run since the seventh inning of the Elon game on April 20. The Virginia Beach, Va. native has now made 56 starts, which is the school record. He also ranks in the top in W&M school history in wins (10th - 17), innings pitched (third - 337.0), strikeouts (seventh - 229), and pick-offs (10th - 6).

- On the offensive end, the Tribe is fourth in the CAA with 276 runs scored. The team has put at least eight runs on the scoreboard in 13 games, going 11-2. W&M ranks 93rd in the NCAA with 92 doubles, while its 20 triples are good for 13th in the NCAA.

- Senior Hunter Smith became the 20th player in school history to record 200 career hits in the doubleheader on Saturday against Elon. The senior ranks second in the CAA with 11 homers, while his 27 career bombs are good for ninth in W&M history.

- Classmate Zach Pearson is enjoying a strong close to his Tribe career. He leads the team and ranks eighth in the CAA with a .311 batting average this year. The senior also leads the team in multi-hit games with 17, including a pair of games in the Charleston series. Pearson has added 13 doubles, three triples, a homer, and 30 RBI.

- Plumeri Park, the home of the Tribe Baseball, turns 20 this spring. The anniversary will be celebrated and recognized over the course of the season. The facility was constructed in large part due to the generous donation by Mr. Joseph J. Plumeri II in the autumn of 1996. It is now considered one of the finest baseball facilities in the region, consistently receiving upgrades over the course of time. W&M has enjoyed a lot of success at Plumeri Park with a 394-207 (.656) since its completion.

Brian Murphy was named head coach of the Tribe baseball program on Dec. 3, 2013, and enters his sixth season as the Tribe's head coach. It will be his seventh season in Williamsburg, after spending one season as the Tribe's top assistant coach.

The former one-year assistant guided the Green and Gold to three 30-plus win seasons, a NCAA Regional Final appearances and a Colonial Athletic Association Tournament bid each season in his first four years as the skipper. Before his promotion, Murphy helped the Tribe earn its first-ever NCAA Tournament at-large bid and win its first regional games in school history on the strength of a record-setting 39-win season in 2013. He made a seamless transition to head coach the following year as W&M secured its first-ever regular season conference title, culminating in CAA Coach of the Year honors. A couple seasons later, W&M captured its first CAA tournament championship since 2001 en route to reaching the NCAA Regional Final for the second time in a four-year span.

In 2017, a third-place finish in the CAA standings allowed W&M to make its fifth consecutive postseason appearance, which is a program-best since qualifying started for the CAA Baseball Tournament. Murphy secured his 100th career victory mid-way through the season after the Tribe edged conference rival UNCW, 10-9, on March 26. At the end of the regular season, the Green and Gold landed five players on the all-conference teams, highlighted by junior Cullen Large receiving All-CAA First Team accolades. Senior Ryder Miconi, who was tabbed All-CAA Third Team, continued to excel in the classroom as he repeated as CAA Scholar Athlete of the Year. In addition, All-CAA second teamer Brandon Raquet was named to Collegiate Baseball's Freshman All-American Team. Murphy also helped produced a draft class of at least three W&M players for the fifth time in program history. Redshirt sophomore Nick Raquet became the third-highest all-time MLB draft pick by getting selected in the third round by the Washington Nationals. Large was chosen in the fifth round by the Toronto Blue Jays and senior Nick Brown was picked by the Minnesota Twins in the 32nd round. It was the second time in program history that two players were taken inside the first five rounds of the MLB Draft.

The 2016 season will go down as one of the most memorable seasons in program history. Down 8-1 in what looked like its final at-bat of the season, the Tribe answered with seven runs in the ninth and sparked a two-week run for the ages. Following a 27-hour rain delay, W&M went onto win the first CAA Championship game in 12 innings, before senior Josh Smith's grand-slam homer in the bottom of the eighth inning lifted them to the CAA Tournament crown and automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. In the NCAA Regional, the Tribe, which fell in its first game, knocked out Bryant and defending national champion Virginia on its way to its second Regional Final in four seasons. When all was said and done the Green and Gold won six elimination games against Northeastern, College of Charleston, UNCW (twice), Bryant, and Virginia. For his efforts, Murphy was named VaSID Coach of the Year. Individually, he helped lead six Tribe players to all-conference awards, including senior Charley Gould, 23732junior Ryder Miconi, and sophomore Ryan Hall, who were named to the second team. Miconi was rewarded for his hard work in the classroom by being named the CAA Scholar Athlete of the Year. Gould became the 35th player in school history to be drafted when the Oakland Athletics drafted him in the 26th round. It was the fifth straight season that the Tribe had a player selected in the MLB Draft.

Throughout his stint in the W&M dugout, Murphy has mentored a total of nine MLB Draft picks, two national award semifinalists and 23 all-conference players. Michael Katz (2012-14), who garnered multiple All-American honors, was tabbed a Golden Spikes Award semifinalist in 2014. Additionally, Katz and Charley Gould (2013-16) were just two of three players in program history to become Dick Hower Trophy semifinalists, representing W&M on the prestigious list in back-to-back years ('14 & '15). Murphy also helped develop a plethora of record-setting athletes. Under his watch, four pitching records were shattered as John Farrell (2010-13) set a new single-season wins standard (11), Jason Inghram (2012-15) replaced the school's all-time wins mark (26), Joseph Gaouette (2013-16) broke the career saves record (18), and Charlie Fletcher became the all-time appearance leader (105). Additionally, Katz eclipsed the single-season RBI ledger (75), while Ryan Hall raised the bar for most career at bats (844).

The Easton Mass. native, who enters his sixth season with the Tribe baseball program, after spending three-seasons at Ivy League school Brown.

While at Brown, Murphy served as the Bears recruiting coordinator and hitting coach. During his three-year tenure in Providence, R.I., Murphy mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections.

Prior to his time with the Bears, Murphy was an assistant at Bryant University in Smithfield, R.I., (2006-09) where he was the recruiting director for the Bulldogs. His on the field responsibilities at Bryant included overseeing the catchers, outfielders and batting. In 2008, he was a member of a Bulldog squad that captured the Northeast-10 Championship. His tenure at Bryant was highlighted by 132 victories, two NCAA Tournament Regional final appearances and a school-record 42 wins in 2008. At the plate, Bryant improved every season in batting average and runs per game under Murphy's tutelage.

In 2004 and 2005, Murphy served as an assistant at Wheaton College in Norton, Ma. While coaching at Wheaton, Murphy's coaching engagement centered on the Lyons' hitting approach and catchers. The Lyons captured two New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) titles and made it all the way to the 2005 NCAA New England Regional finals during Murphy's two seasons.

Murphy has summer coaching experience in the Cape Cod League and the Northwoods League. Murphy served as the hitting coach for the CCBL's Hyannis Mets during the summers of 2005 and 2006. In 2008, he was the Head Coach of the Battle Creek (MI) Bombers of the Northwoods League.

He played collegiately at Merrimack College in North Andover, Mass., where he was the team captain in 2003. Murphy earned a degree in business management from Merrimack in 2003 and a Master's Degree in Sports Management from California University of Pennsylvania in 2009.

Murphy resides in Williamsburg with his wife, Karen, son, Connor, and daughter Maggie.
