INSIDE THE TRIBE

THE GAME

The William & Mary football team will begin one of the most unique seasons in the program's 127-year history when it squares off against longtime rival Richmond for the Capital Cup on Saturday at 1 p.m. The contest, which will be televised by NBC Sports Washington, will mark the first of a six-game spring slate that features two matchups versus the Spiders, James Madison and Elon.

ABOUT THE TRIBE

After winning three of its final four games to conclude the 2019 campaign, including a season-ending victory at Richmond, W&M enters the spring slate eager to build upon the program's success. Anchored by a talented and experienced offensive line, the Tribe's scoring production looks to continue the upward trajectory that began last season under the direction of dynamic sophomore quarterback Hollis Mathis. Nearly all of the Tribe's rushing and receiving production returns from a season ago. While just three starters return on defense, the unit is replete with talented, athletic playmakers.

SCOUTING THE SPIDERS

Richmond returns 17 starters, nine on offense and eight on defense) from last season's team that posted a 5-7 record overall and a 4-4 mark in conference play. Senior quarterback Joe Mancuso enters his third year as a starter and ranked second in the CAA in total offense last season (2,775). On the defensive side, defensive lineman Kobie Turner earned preseason All-America honors by Hero Sports after leading the Spiders with 14.5 TFL and 7.0 sacks in 2019. Aaron Dyke also garnered preseason All-America accolades by Athlon Sports as a kick returner.

ABOUT THE SERIES

Saturday's game between William & Mary and Richmond will mark the 131st meeting between the two schools in what has been traditionally called the "Oldest Rivalry in the South" – but may be more accurately described as the most PLAYED rivalry in the South. W&M leads the all-time series, 63-62-5. The teams first met in 1898, when Richmond blanked W&M, 15-0.

Only three other Division I series have a longer history than that of W&M vs. UR.

■ W&M/RICHMOND NOTES

LAST MEETING

W&M reclaimed the Capital Cup with a thrilling 21-15 overtime victory at Richmond in its 2019 season finale.

Freshman quarterback Hollis Mathis provided the game-winning touchdown pass when he connected with junior wideout Zach Burdick on a 23-yard strike. W&M's score came after senior defensive tackle Bill Murray blocked a 32-yard field goal attempt by UR's Jake Larson during the Spiders' overtime possession.

Jones was selected as the Capital Cup Most Valuable Player after totaling a team-high nine tackles with 2.0 sacks, 4.0 TFL, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a PBU.

W&M-UR RECENT HISTORY

Since the two teams started meeting as conference opponents in 1993, Richmond owns a 15-13 edge. During that stretch, UR owns an 8-7 edge in Richmond and a 7-6 edge in Williamsburg.

Since 1993, the two squads have only played seven games decided by three points or less (W&M is 4-3 in such contests). Conversely, 17 of the games during the same span have been decided by double-digit margins (UR owns an 9-8 edge in such games).

W&M-UR SEASON OPENER

Saturday's matchup will mark just the second time W&M and UR have met in a season opener, with the lone other instance in 1899 at Richmond.

The contest was just the second-ever meeting between the two schools, which UR won, 14-0.

A KEY TO VICTORY

W&M's ability to run the ball successfully against Richmond has been a key to its last four victories in the series. In those games, the Tribe has averaged 220.5 rushing yards per game (882 yards). Conversely, it has averaged just 81.2 rushing yards per game during its last 12 losses in the series (974 yards).

SEE YA SOON

Saturday's game will mark the first of three scheduled matchups between W&M and UR in 2021, as the Spiders will visit Zable Stadium later this spring (April 10) and again in the fall (Nov. 20).

W&M-UR CONNECTIONS

In addition to winning a national championship as head coach at Richmond in 2008, W&M Head Coach Mike London was also a standout defensive back for the Spiders (1979-82) and served as a team captain as a senior. Additionally, he spent two stints as an assistant at UR.

W&M Associate Head Coach, Defensive Coordinator, Vince Brown, coached linebackers at Richmond for both seasons (2008-09) that London served as the Spiders' head coach.

On the UR sidelines, Head Coach Russ Huesman has ties to W&M.

Huesman worked as an assistant at W&M from 1985-97 and served as the defensive coordinator his final two seasons.

■ TEAM NOTES

SEASON OPENERS

Although W&M has traditionally opened its season versus Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponents, this will mark the third consecutive season in which it has started its slate against a Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) foe.

The Tribe won both of the recent contests, defeating Bucknell in 2018 and Lafayette in 2019.

W&M last opened its season versus a conference opponent in 2010 when it fell at Massachusetts, 27-23.

CAPTAINS

Serving as team captains this season are senior linebacker Tyler Crist, senior quarterback Ted Hefter, senior defensive end Carl Fowler and junior defensive end Carl Fowler. All four were selected by a vote of their teammates.

Of the four, only Fowler was recruited as a scholarship player.

NEWCOMERS

Of the 93 players on W&M's roster, 30 are newcomers this season.

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

During the last two seasons, W&M is 7-1 when it commits fewer turnovers than its opponents, while it is 0-9 when it loses the turnover battle during the recent stretch.

The Tribe forced 24 turnovers last season, which ranked tied for third in the CAA.

20 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

W&M owns an 10-3 record during the last three seasons in games in which it scored more than 20 points. All three losses have come in conference play this season (UAlbany, Villanova, Maine).

BLOCKING KICKS

W&M has ranked among the nation's top teams blocking kicks in recent years and that trend continued in 2019 when it ranked sixth nationally with six blocks.

LEADING AT HALFTIME

Dating back to the 2014 season, the Tribe has won 17 of its last 21 games when leading at halftime.

Three of those setbacks came against Towson (2016, 2017, 2018), while the other was at UAlbany (2019).

HOLDING ON TO LEADS

Dating back to the start of the 2013 season, W&M owns a 33-4 record when leading after three quarters.

The three losses came against UAlbany, 2019; Delaware, 2015; JMU, 2014; Villanova, 2013.

TRIBE IN THE NFL

Three former Tribe standouts were on NFL rosters this season - DeAndre Houston-Carson (Bears), Luke Rhodes (Colts) and Bill Murray (Patriots).

Additionally, a pair of former Tribe players are currently serving as NFL head coaches - Mike Tomlin '95 (Pittsburgh Steelers, head coach) and Sean McDermott '98 (Buffalo Bills). Additionally, Joe Brady '13 is currently the Carolina Panthers offensive coordinator.

Also noteworthy is a pair of former W&M head coaches who went on to have extraordinary Hall of Fame careers - Marv Levy and Lou Holtz. Levy served as W&M's head coach from 1964-68 and was followed by Holtz from 1969-71.

■ TEAM OFFENSIVE NOTES

WELCOME BACK

After leading one of the nation's most productive offensive units at the University of San Diego the past two seasons, former W&M quarterback and assistant coach Christian Taylor returns to his alma mater as the Tribe's offensive coordinator this season after being hired last February.

Taylor, who played quarterback at W&M from 2002-06 and was an assistant coach on the Tribe's staff for two seasons (2008-09), returns to Williamsburg with impressive credentials that includes being selected as a finalist as the 2018 FCS Coordinator of the Year.

RETURNING PRODUCTION

In addition to returning record-setting quarterback Hollis Mathis, W&M brings back a wealth of talent on the offensive side. Anchored by a veteran group of offensive linemen, which includes four returning starters, the Tribe also brings back its top four rushers and top seven receivers from last season.

TRENDING UPWARDS

In head coach Mike London's first season leading W&M, the Tribe dramatically improved in a number of offensive statistical categories. In addition to nearly doubling its scoring production from the previous year (25.2), W&M increased its total offense by nearly 100 yards per game. The Tribe also increased its rushing average by more than 130 yards per contest and more than quadrupled its rushing touchdown total (26) - an impressive figure that ranked just outside the program's all-time top-10 list.

GROUND GAME PRODUCTION IS KEY

Since joining the league in 1993, W&M has rushed for at least 200 yards 80 times and posted a 75-5 record in those contests.

Additionally, W&M is 30-4 when out-rushing the opposition since 2013.

STAT TO WATCH

Dating back through the 2011 season, W&M has struggled to win games in which it has thrown at least 30 passes and owns an 11-26 mark in such contests.

■ TEAM DEFENSIVE NOTES

NEW OPPORTUNITIES

With the return of just three starters on the defensive side, their are opportunities for a number of talented players to take on a bigger role this season.

Perhaps no player on the defensive side embodies what maximizing the opportunity can mean more than linebacker Isaiah Jones. Making his first career start as a redshirt freshman at Richmond last season, he was voted as the Capital Cup MVP after totaling a team-high nine tackles with 2.0 sacks, 4.0 TFL, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a PBU.

SACKS

With 30 sacks last season, W&M more than doubled its total from previous year (11) and was just one shy of breaking into the program's all-time top-10 list.

FORCING TURNOVERS

In addition to leading the Colonial Athletic Association with 2.0 forced turnovers per game, the Tribe's 24 forced turnovers marked the program's highest total since 2009.

STOPPING THE RUN

By limiting opponents to just 152.9 rushing yards per game last season, W&M was just 3.0 yards from ranking among the program's all-time top-10 list.

TOUGH TO SCORE THROUGH THE AIR

Since the start of the start of the 2016 season, a span of 44 games, just 13 opponents have scored more than one passing touchdown against W&M.

SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

Since the start of the 2007 season, a span of 147 games, the Tribe has allowed more than 300 passing yards just 10 times.

TOUGH DEFENSE AT ZABLE STADIUM

The Tribe defense has been outstanding in home games since the start of the 2009 season and is allowing just 18.8 points per game at Zable Stadium during the stretch.

During the stretch of 59 games (1,108 points), W&M has posted six shutouts.

W&M owns a 38-21 record at home during that span.

Tremendously successful and widely respected, Mike London enters his second year as head coach of the William & Mary football program.

London's first season leading the Tribe provided a glimpse of the program's bright future, as the squad concluded the 2019 campaign with wins in three of its final four games – including a Capital Cup victory at long-time rival Richmond in the season finale. In addition to helping five W&M standouts earn all-conference honors, defensive tackle Bill Murray garnered All-America distinction and signed a free agent contract with the New England Patriots. Additionally, four members of the squad earned Freshman All-America honors.

Under London's leadership, the Tribe also dramatically improved in a number of offensive statistical categories during his first season in Williamsburg. In addition to nearly doubling its scoring production from the previous year (25.2), W&M increased its total offense by nearly 100 yards per game. The Tribe also increased its rushing average by more than 130 yards per contest and more than quadrupled its rushing touchdown total (26) – an impressive figure that ranked just outside the program's all-time top-10 list.

The Tribe also excelled academically under London's leadership, as a program-record 51 student-athletes earned CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll distinction during the spring semester.

London, a former assistant under longtime Tribe head coach Jimmye Laycock, returned to Williamsburg with an impressive list of accomplishments as a head coach that includes winning a national title at the University of Richmond (2008) and earning Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year distinction at the University of Virginia (2011).

Howard University's head coach from 2017-18, London's tenure leading the Bison was highlighted with his selection as a finalist for the 2017 STATS Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Eddie Robinson Award, which is bestowed upon the nation's top head coach. Additionally, he earned the 2017 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Regional Coach of the Year award after guiding Howard to a 6-2 conference record – the program's first winning season since 2012. His inaugural campaign at HU featured a season-opening win at UNLV, which ESPN lauded as one of college football's greatest upsets.

Prior to his two-year stint at HU, London served as an associate head coach/defensive line coach at the University of Maryland in 2016 where he helped lead the Terps to an appearance in the Quick Lane Bowl.

In addition to garnering ACC Coach of the Year

honors at UVA in 2011, London led the Cavaliers to the Chick-Fil-A Bowl. En route to earning the postseason bowl bid, he guided UVA to road wins at Miami and Florida State – becoming the first program in the nation to accomplish the feat in the same season.

London gained his first head coaching experience at Richmond, his alma mater, where he amassed a 24-5 record and guided the Spiders to the 2008 FCS national title during his initial campaign. His efforts were recognized by the AFCA, which selected him as the FCS National Coach of the Year. After leading the Spiders to an 8-0 start the following season, UR became just the third FCS school to receive a vote in the Associated Press (AP) Poll.

London landed the head coaching job at UR after an exceptional two-year stint as UVA's defensive coordinator (2006-07). During his first season, the Cavaliers allowed just 289.5 yards per game – the program's best figure in 27 years. The following season, London's defense ranked sixth nationally in sacks and among the nation's top 20 in scoring defense and rushing defense. London oversaw the development of an outstanding group of All-ACC honorees, highlighted by 2007 unanimous All-America standout Chris Long, who was the second overall pick in the 2008 NFL Draft.

Before returning to UVA, where he was an assistant from 2001-04, London spent the 2005 season in the NFL as the Houston Texans' defensive line coach. London's first stint with the Cavaliers also included serving as the program's recruiting coordinator from 2002-04.

London, a native of Hampton, Va., began his coaching career as the outside linebackers coach at Richmond in 1988 before coaching the defensive line at William & Mary under Jimmye Laycock (1991-94). He then returned to UR for two more years (1995-96) as the outside linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator before taking on the defensive line coaching duties at Boston College from 1997-00.

A standout defensive back at Richmond (1979-82), London served as a team captain his senior season and was signed by the Dallas Cowboys as a free agent in 1983.

London graduated from UR in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in sociology and a year later earned a degree in law enforcement from the Richmond Police Academy. He served as a detective from 1985-87.

London and his wife, Regina, have four children: daughters Ticynn, Jaicyn and Madicyn and son Korben. He has three children from a previous marriage: sons Michael Jr. and Brandon, and daughter Kristen.
