

#### THE GAME

William & Mary will conclude its regular season slate when it hosts Richmond for The Capital Cup Game presented by C&F Bank at Zable Stadium on Saturday at 3:30 p.m. W&M will honor 23 seniors prior to kickoff. The contest will be televised by Cox YurView, while a video stream will be available at FloFootball.com.



#### **ABOUT THE TRIBE**

W&M will look to snap a two-game skid this Saturday and enters the weekend with a 6-4 record overall and a 4-3 mark in league play. W&M continues to lead the Colonial Athletic Association in rushing and is averaging 204.7 yards per game on the ground, while it has posted a league-best 18 rushing touchdowns. Conversely, the Tribe ranks 16th nationally in rushing defense (103.8) and has allowed just 69.5 rushing yards per game in its lasts three contests. Additionally, the Tribe ranks 14th nationally with 20 takeaways, which includes nine interceptions - a figure that ranks tied for ninth in the country.

#### **SCOUTING THE SPIDERS**

Richmond, which has won its last three games, enters Saturday's contest with a 5-5 record overall and a 3-4 mark in league play. The Spiders are averaging 38.0 points per game during its current winning streak, while they rank third in the conference in scoring defense (20.3) and total defense (331.0).

#### **ABOUT THE SERIES**

Saturday's game between William & Mary and Richmond will mark the 132nd meeting between the two schools in what has been traditionally called the "Oldest Rivalry in the South" - but may be more accurately described as the most PLAYED rivalry in the South. The all-time series is tied, 63-63-5. The teams first met in 1898, when Richmond blanked W&M, 15-0. Only three other Division I series have a longer history than that of W&M vs. UR.

#### ■ W&M/UR NOTES

#### **LAST MEETING**

W&M fell at Richmond, 21-14, in its 2021 spring season opener. The Tribe led in the fourth quarter, 14-13, but the Spiders regained the lead with 6:20 remaining and held on for a 21-14 win. Joe Mancuso's 6-yard touchdown pass to John Fitzgerald flipped the lead, and W&M's offense was on the field for only three plays the rest of the way.

Quarterback Hollis Mathis accounted for 220 yards and both of his team's touchdowns.

Defensively, the Tribe held Richmond to 310 yards, 159 of which came on two possessions.

#### WE'VE MET BEFORE

Just three other Division I series have a longer history than that of W&M vs. UR.

#### W&M-UR RECENT HISTORY

Since the two teams started meeting as conference opponents in 1993, Richmond owns a 16-13 edge. During that stretch, UR owns an 9-7 edge in Richmond and a 7-6 edge in Williamsburg.

Since 1993, the two squads have only played seven games decided by three points or less (W&M is 4-3 in such contests). Conversely, 17 of the games during the same span have been decided by double-digit margins (UR owns an 9-8 edge in such games).

#### A KEY TO VICTORY

W&M's ability to run the ball successfully against Richmond has been a key to its last four victories in the series. In those games, the Tribe has averaged 220.5 rushing yards per game (882 yards).

Conversely, it has averaged just 80.5 rushing yards per game during its last 13 losses in the series (1,046 yards).

#### **W&M-UR CONNECTIONS**

In addition to winning a national championship as head coach at Richmond in 2008, W&M Head Coach Mike London was also a standout defensive back for the Spiders (1979-82) and served as a team captain as a senior. Additionally, he spent two stints as an assistant at UR.

W&M Associate Head Coach, Defensive Coordinator, Vince Brown, coached linebackers at Richmond for both seasons (2008-09) that London served as the Spiders' head coach.

On the UR sidelines, Head Coach Russ Huesman and running backs coach David Corley have ties to W&M

Huesman worked as an assistant at W&M from 1985-97 and served as the defensive coordinator his final two seasons. Corely, one of the greatest quarterbacks in school history and a member of the W&M Hall of Fame, was an assistant on the Tribe's staff from 2008-13.

#### **■ TEAM NOTES**

#### **SENIOR DAY**

Prior to Saturday's kickoff, W&M will honor 23 seniors who will play in their final regular season game with the Tribe - captains Zach Burdick, Tyler Crist and Ryan Ripley, as well as Cole Blackman, Elijah Burns, Ryan Childress, Thomas Creed, Seth Dunn, Dan Evers, Griffin Gilder, Jarrett Heckert, Gage Herdman, Will Kiely, Anthony Mague, Aaron Maisus, Will Michael, Joey Nameth, Marteise Phipps, Cory Ryder, Andrew Trainer, Amonyae Watson, Will Whitehurst and Trey Zgombic.

#### **BACK IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS**

Despite falling out of the national rankings following its 32-22 setback against No. 2 James Madison last Saturday, W&M's spent the previous two weeks among the top-25.

Prior to garnering its ranking this season, W&M last earned a spot in the national top 25 in 2016.

#### **TURNOVER MARGIN**

With a +5 turnover margin, W&M currently ranks tied for 24th nationally.

#### WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

During the last four seasons, W&M is 12-2 when it commits fewer turnovers than its opponents, while it is 2-12 when it loses the turnover battle during the recent stretch. The only wins came against Elon last spring and this fall.

#### **20 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER**

W&M owns an 17-4 record during the last four seasons in games in which it scored more than 20 points.

It owns a 6-1 mark in those games this season.

#### **LEADING AT HALFTIME**

Dating back to the 2014 season, the Tribe has won 23 of its last 27 games when leading at halftime.

Three of those setbacks came against Towson (2016, 2017, 2018), while the other was at UAlbany (2019).

#### **HOLDING ON TO LEADS**

Dating back to the start of the 2013 season, W&M owns a 39-4 record when leading after three quarters

The three losses came against UAlbany, 2019; Delaware, 2015; JMU, 2014; Villanova, 2013.

#### **COMEBACK WINS**

W&M's impressive comeback win against UAlbany earlier this season marked the 23rd time the Tribe has rallied back from a double-digit second half deficit dating back through 1970.

#### A SIGN OF GOOD THINGS TO COME

The Tribe's victory at Elon in its conference opener may indicate a sign of good things to come this season. During the previous 28 seasons (excluding the abbreviated three-game CoVID slate in spring 2021), W&M has averaged nearly nine wins (8.7) in the 10 years it has started the league slate with a victory (the Tribe's combined winning percentage for those 10 seasons is .702, 87-37). Additionally, W&M has never failed to win less than seven games during a season in which it started conference play with a victory. Six of the program's seven NCAA playoff appearances since 1993 have come in seasons that have started with a victory in conference play.

Conversely, in the 17 seasons W&M has lost its conference opener it has averaged 5.2 wins for a .468 winning percentage (89-101). The 2010 season marked the only time during the 28-year stretch that W&M had lost its conference opener and won more than seven games.

#### **GRADUATES**

More than 20 percent of W&M's roster is comprised of student-athletes who have already earned their undergraduate degrees (19 total players).

Highlighting the impressive group is second-year Law student Carl Fowler, who serves as a Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) representative on the NCAA Football Student-Athlete Connection Group.

#### **CAPTAINS**

Serving as team captains this season are five seniors - defensive tackle Zyquan Bessant, wide receiver Zach Burdick, linebacker Tyler Crist, defensive end Carl Fowler and offensive lineman Ryan Ripley.

Crist, Fowler and Ripley served as captains last season.

Of the five, only Fowler was recruited as a scholarship player.

#### TRIBE IN THE NFL

Three former Tribe standouts are on NFL rosters this season - DeAndre Houston-Carson (Bears), Luke Rhodes (Colts) and Bill Murray (Patriots).

Additionally, a pair of former Tribe players are currently serving as NFL head coaches - Mike Tomlin '95 (Pittsburgh Steelers, head coach) and Sean McDermott '98 (Buffalo Bills), while Joe Brady '13 is currently the Carolina Panthers offensive coordinator.

Also noteworthy is a pair of former W&M head coaches who went on to have extraordinary Hall of Fame careers - Marv Levy and Lou Holtz. Levy served as W&M's head coach from 1964-68 and was followed by Holtz from 1969-71.

#### ■ TEAM OFFENSIVE NOTES

#### **BEST RUSHING ATTACK IN THE CAA**

W&M currently leads the CAA and ranks 14th nationally with 204.7 rushing yards per game.

W&M's current average of 5.05 yards per carry is threatening the school record of 5.14 set in 1990.

The Tribe also leads the CAA with 18 rushing touchdowns.

#### **BALANCED ATTACK**

W&M currently has three players who are averaging more than 50 rushing yards per game - Donavyn Lester (64.9), Malachi Imoh (62.2) and Bronson Yoder (61.1).

#### PROTECTING THE QB

W&M ranks tied for ninth nationally with just 10 sacks surrendered this season. Additionally, it ranks tied for seventh in sacks allowed per game (1.0).

#### **OFFENSIVE LINE ADJUSTMENTS**

Expected to be one of W&M's strengths this season, the offensive line featured a talented group that entered the fall with a combined 78 career starts. However, due to injuries and illness, W&M utilized different starting lineups along the offensive front in each of the first seven games this season.

#### **GROUND GAME PRODUCTION IS KEY**

Since joining the CAA in 1993, W&M has rushed for at least 200 yards 86 times and posted a 79-7 record in those contests. Two of those losses came this season, however, at Maine and against JMU.

Additionally, W&M is 36-7 when out-rushing the opposition since 2013.

#### **STAT TO WATCH**

Dating back through the 2011 season, W&M has struggled to win games in which it has thrown at least 30 passes and owns an 11-26 mark in such contests.

#### **CREATING TURNOVERS**

W&M has totaled 20 takeaways this season - 13 interceptions and seven fumble recoveries - which ranks tied for 14th nationally.

The Tribe has generated at least one turnover in eight of the last nine games.

#### **NO FLY ZONE**

W&M currently ranks tied for ninth nationally with 13 interceptions.

The Tribe's last eight interceptions have all come by different players.

#### SACKING THE OPPOSITION

W&M currently ranks fourth in the CAA with 24 sacks.

#### **SLOWING DOWN THE RUN**

W&M currently ranks third in the CAA and 16th in the nation in rushing defense (103.8).

The Tribe has allowed just 69.5 rushing yards per game in its last three contests.

#### **SCORING WITH DEFENSE**

W&M has recorded three non-offensive touchdowns this season, two coming on pick-sixes and one on a fumbled snap on a punt.

Dating back to 2007, the Tribe has generated 44 non-offensive touchdowns.

#### TOUGH TO SCORE THROUGH THE AIR

Since the start of the start of the 2016 season, a span of 57 games, just 19 opponents have scored more than one passing touchdown against W&M.

#### SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

Since the start of the 2007 season, a span of 160 games, the Tribe has allowed more than 300 passing yards just 13 times.

#### **TOUGH DEFENSE AT ZABLE STADIUM**

The Tribe defense has been outstanding in home games since the start of the 2009 season and is allowing just 18.9 points per game at Zable Stadium during the stretch.

During the stretch of 65 games (1,229 points), W&M has posted six shutouts.

W&M owns a 42-23 record at home during that span.

# MIKE LONDON

Tremendously successful and widely respected, Mike London enters his third year as head coach of the William & Mary football program.

Although the COVID-19 global pandemic limited last season's campaign to a three-game slate during the spring, London successfully guided the program through the challenges. A pair of standouts – left tackle Andrew Trainer and defensive end Will Kiely – both earned all-conference honors, while standout freshman running back Malachi Imoh garnered all-state distinction.

The team also continued its tradition of academic excellence, as a program-record 69 players earned CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll Accolades during the fall semester.

London's first season leading the Tribe provided a glimpse of the program's bright future, as the squad concluded the 2019 campaign with wins in three of its final four games – including a Capital Cup victory at long-time rival Richmond in the season finale. In addition to helping five W&M standouts earn all-conference honors, defensive tackle Bill Murray garnered All-America distinction and signed a free agent contract with the New England Patriots. Additionally, four members of the squad earned Freshman All-America honors.

Under London's leadership, the Tribe also dramatically improved in a number of offensive statistical categories during his first season in Williamsburg. In addition to nearly doubling its scoring production from the previous year (25.2), W&M increased its total offense by nearly 100 yards per game. The Tribe also increased its rushing average by more than 130 yards per contest and more than quadrupled its rushing touchdown total (26) – an impressive figure that ranked just outside the program's all-time top-10 list.

The Tribe also excelled academically under London's leadership, as a then-program-record 51 student-athletes earned CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll distinction during the spring semester.

London, a former assistant under longtime Tribe head coach Jimmye Laycock, returned to Williamsburg with an impressive list of accomplishments as a head coach that includes winning a national title at the University of Richmond (2008) and earning Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year distinction at the University of Virginia (2011).

Howard University's head coach from 2017-18, London's tenure leading the Bison was highlighted with his selection as a finalist for the 2017 STATS Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Eddie Robinson Award, which is bestowed upon the nation's top head coach. Additionally, he earned the 2017 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Regional Coach of the Year award after guiding Howard to a 6-2 conference record – the program's first winning season since 2012. His inaugural campaign at HU featured a

season-opening win at UNLV, which ESPN lauded as one of college football's greatest upsets.

Prior to his two-year stint at HU, London served as an associate head coach/defensive line coach at the University of Maryland in 2016 where he helped lead the Terps to an appearance in the Quick Lane Bowl.

In addition to garnering ACC Coach of the Year honors at UVA in 2011, London led the Cavaliers to the Chick-Fil-A Bowl. En route to earning the postseason bowl bid, he guided UVA to road wins at Miami and Florida State – becoming the first program in the nation to accomplish the feat in the same season.

London gained his first head coaching experience at Richmond, his alma mater, where he amassed a 24-5 record and guided the Spiders to the 2008 FCS national title during his initial campaign. His efforts were recognized by the AFCA, which selected him as the FCS National Coach of the Year. After leading the Spiders to an 8-0 start the following season, UR became just the third FCS school to receive a vote in the Associated Press (AP) Poll.

London landed the head coaching job at UR after an exceptional two-year stint as UVA's defensive coordinator (2006-07). During his first season, the Cavaliers allowed just 289.5 yards per game – the program's best figure in 27 years. The following season, London's defense ranked sixth nationally in sacks and among the nation's top 20 in scoring defense and rushing defense. London oversaw the development of an outstanding group of All-ACC honorees, highlighted by 2007 unanimous All-America standout Chris Long, who was the second overall pick in the 2008 NFL Draft.

Before returning to UVA, where he was an assistant from 2001-04, London spent the 2005 season in the NFL as the Houston Texans' defensive line coach. London's first stint with the Cavaliers also included serving as the program's recruiting coordinator from 2002-04.

London, a native of Hampton, Va., began his coaching career as the outside linebackers coach at Richmond in 1988 before coaching the defensive line at William & Mary under Jimmye Laycock (1991-94). He then returned to UR for two more years (1995-96) as the outside linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator before taking on the defensive line coaching duties at Boston College from 1997-00.

A standout defensive back at Richmond (1979-82), London served as a team captain his senior season and was signed by the Dallas Cowboys as a free agent in 1983

London graduated from UR in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in sociology and a year later earned a degree in law enforcement from the Richmond Police Academy. He served as a detective from 1985-87.

London and his wife, Regina, have four children: daughters Ticynn, Jaicyn and Madicyn and son Korben. He has three children from a previous marriage: sons Michael Jr. and Brandon, and daughter Kristen.
