No. 24 William & Mary will hit the road for the second consecutive weekend when it plays at North Carolina A&T on Saturday at 1 p.m. The contest will be available on FloCollege, while a radio broadcast will be available on 92.3 FM The Tide.

ABOUT THE TRIBE

W&M enters the weekend with a 5-3 overall record and a 2-2 mark in conference play after falling at then-

No. 24 Stony Brook last Saturday. The Tribe boasts one of the nation's top offensive attacks and currently ranks 12th nationally in total offense (443.1) and third in rushing (257.4). Running back Bronson Yoder leads the Tribe and ranks 17th nationally with 100.4 rushing yards per game. Defensively, W&M forced at least one turnover in six straight games, totaling 11 turnovers during that span. Cornerback Jalen Jones leads the country in passes defended (16).

SCOUTING THE AGGIES

Currently on a six-game losing streak, North Carolina A&T enters Saturday's game with 1-7 record overall and a 0-4 mark in CAA play. The Aggies rank last in the conference in scoring offense (17.9) and scoring defense (39.8). Kenji Christian leads A&T in rushing with 85.3 yards per game, while Ger-Carl Caldwell has totaled a team-high 36 receptions for 454 yards and three touchdowns. Defensively, Henry Daniel leads the team in sacks (4) and TFL (8), while Mack David II has posted a team-leading 51 tackles to go with a sack and 3.5 TFL.

■ TEAM NOTES

HELLO AGAIN

The North Carolina A&T sidelines will feature a number of familiar coaches this weekend, as four members of the Aggies' staff have ties to W&M. Head coach Vincent Brown was the Tribe's defensive coordinator from 2019-22, while defensive assistant Alex Purviance was a linebacker at W&M and served as the Tribe's defensive/special teams quality control coach. Defensive coordinator/linebackers coach Josh Zidenberg and cornerbacks coach Almondo Curry also served as assistants with the Tribe.

NATIONAL RANKING

W&M enters Saturday's game ranked No. 24 in AFCA FCS Coaches' Top 25 Poll and in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 Poll.

In addition to earning a top-25 national ranking each of the last four seasons, W&M has appeared in the top 10 three straight seasons.

WINNING SEASONS

With two more victories, W&M will secure its fourth consecutive winning season, which would mark the first time the Tribe has accomplished the feat since posting eight straight winning seasons from 1992-99.

CONTROLLING THE CLOCK

Having established itself as one of the country's top teams on both sides of the ball this season, W&M has controlled time of possession and currently ranks 17th nationally (32:07).

HALFTIME ADJUSTMENTS

W&M has outscored its opponents in the second half, 111-79, which includes a 70-27 margin in the fourth quarter.

RUSHING TO SUCCESS

W&M is 5-0 this season when it outgains its opponents on the ground. In those victories the Tribe is averaging 324.2 rushing yards per contest.

20 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

W&M owns an 38-9 record during the last seven seasons in games in which it scored more than 20 points.

During the last four seasons, W&M is 27-6 in such contests.

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

During the last seven seasons, W&M is 24-4 when it commits fewer turnovers than its opponents, while it is 4-18 when it loses the turnover battle during the recent stretch.

LEADING AT HALFTIME

Dating back to the 2014 season, the Tribe has won 40 of its last 47 games when leading at halftime.

HOLDING ON TO LEADS

Dating back to the start of the 2013 season, W&M owns a 57-6 record when leading after three quarters.

SUCCESS AT HOME

Off to a 4-0 start at home this season, W&M has posted an 11-2 record at Zable Stadium during the last three seasons

SUCCESS vs. FCS IN NON-CONFERENCE

After posting a 3-0 mark against FCS opponents - all versus teams from the Southern Conference - during its non-conference slate, W&M has won 44 of its last 46 games against non-conference FCS opponents during the regular season. The lone losses during that span are Lafayette (2012) and Colgate (2018).

Additionally W&M owns a 47-3 record vs. FCS non-conference teams during the regular season dating back through the 2002 season.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

After establishing themselves among the nation's best players, W&M senior left tackle Charles Grant and senior running back Bronson Yoder were selected to multiple preseason All-America teams this summer. The duo was also tabbed to the East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 Watch List and garnered preseason All-CAA honors by the league's head coaches, while Grant was chosen to the prestigious Senior Bowl Watch List.

PRESEASON ALL-CAA SELECTIONS

In addition to Charles Grant and Bronson Yoder, four other W&M standouts earned preseason all-conference honors - fullback/halfback Trey McDonald, running back Malachi Imoh, offensive lineman Ryan McKenna and safety Marcus Barnes.

CAPTAINS

Serving as team captains this season are six seniors - OL Charles Grant, ATH Hollis Mathis, OL Ryan McKenna, LB Quinn Osborne, LB Alex Washington and RB Bronson Yoder, who is a two-time team captain. The six captains are the most in school history.

TRIBE IN THE NFL

Five former Tribe standouts were in NFL preseason camps this year - linebacker/defensive end Nate Lynn (Lions), All-Pro long snapper Luke Rhodes (Colts), offensive lineman Bill Murray (Bears), offensive lineman Colby Sorsdal (Lions) and running back Owen Wright (Ravens).

Additionally, a pair of former Tribe players are currently serving as NFL head coaches - Mike Tomlin '95 (Pittsburgh Steelers, head coach) and Sean McDermott '98 (Buffalo Bills).

New York Giants head coach Brian Daboll was an assistant on W&M's staff in 1997, while Washington Commanders head coach Dan Quinn was an assistant with the Tribe in 1994.

Also noteworthy is a pair of former W&M head coaches who went on to have extraordinary Hall of Fame careers - Marv Levy and Lou Holtz. Levy served as W&M's head coach from 1964-68 and was followed by Holtz from 1969-71.

■ TEAM OFFENSIVE NOTES

BIG NUMBERS

Under the direction of first-year offensive coordinator Mario Acitelli, W&M's offense is off to a strong start this season and ranks 12th nationally in total offense (443.1), third in rushing (257.4) and 14th in first downs (188).

THIRD DOWN CONVERSIONS

W&M has been tremendously successful converting third downs this season and ranks seventh nationally with a .500 conversion percentage.

RED ZONE TOUCHDOWNS

W&M has scored touchdowns on 26 of its 35 trips into the Red Zone this season (74.3).

5 FOR 400

W&M recorded more than 400 yards of total offense in five consecutive games this season (Wofford through Campbell), marking just the second time in the last nine seasons that the Tribe has posted such a stretch. The only other occasion came in 2022 when it eclipsed the mark in seven consecutive games.

RUSHING FOR 350

Earlier this season, W&M rushed for more than 350 yards three times in a span of four games (Furman through Campbell).marking the first time in school history the Tribe has posted such a remarkable stretch of performances.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOK

In addition to scoring a season-high 49 points in the win against Hampton earlier this season, W&M recorded 632 total yards and 434 rushing yards. The total yardage marked the Tribe's best figure since posting 636 in the 56-0 win against Liberty in 2005, while the rushing yardage ranks third in school history.

COMING FROM EVERY ANGLE

Six different players on W&M's roster have thrown at least one career touchdown pass - Darius Wilson, Hollis Mathis, Tyler Hughes, Sean Kendrick, Malachi Imoh and Andrew Piercy.

GROUND GAME PRODUCTION IS KEY

Since joining the CAA in 1993, W&M has rushed for at least 200 yards 106 times and posted an 96-10 record in those contests.

Additionally, W&M is 55-10 when out-rushing the opposition since 2013.

STAT TO WATCH

Dating back through the 2011 season, W&M has struggled to win games in which it has thrown at least 30 passes and owns an 12-26 mark in such contests.

■ TEAM DEFENSIVE NOTES

STRONG FINISHES

W&M's defense has been tremendous during the fourth quarter this season and has allowed just three touchdowns and 27 points.

STANDING STRONG

W&M's defense has allowed just five rushing touchdowns during the last five games. Just three opponents have found the end zone on the ground more than once versus the Tribe this season (Coastal Carolina, Wofford, Stony Brook).

BALL HAWKS

W&M has recorded at least one interception in five consecutive games and ranks fourth in the CAA with eight interceptions.

The Tribe also ranks tied for second in the CAA with eight forced fumbles.

W&M has forced at least one turnover in six straight games, totaling 11 turnovers during that span.

SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

Since the start of the 2007 season, a span of 192 games, the Tribe has allowed more than 300 passing yards just 14 times. Campbell is the only opponent to accomplish the feat this season.

TOUGH TO SCORE THROUGH THE AIR

Since the start of the start of the 2016 season, a span of 90 games, just 31 opponents have scored more than one passing touchdown against W&M.

During the last three seasons, W&M's defense is allowing just 1.1 touchdown passes per game (37 TD / 32 games).

TOUGH DEFENSE AT ZABLE STADIUM

The Tribe defense has been outstanding in home games since the start of the 2009 season and is allowing just 18.6 points per game at Zable Stadium during the stretch.

During the stretch of 81 games (1,514 points), W&M has posted six shutouts.

W&M is 54-27 at home during that span.

SCORING WITH DEFENSE & SPECIAL TEAMS

After recording two non-offensive touchdowns last season, W&M found the end zone on a blocked punt return against VMI in the season opener.

Dating back to 2007, the Tribe has generated 47 non-offensive touchdowns.

After leading the William & Mary football team to three consecutive winning campaigns, Head Coach Mike London returns for his sixth season at the helm of the Tribe.

W&M ascended as high as No. 4 in the national rankings in 2023, marking the third straight season in which the Tribe garnered a national ranking and the second straight year in which it appeared in the top 10.

During the recent stretch of success, London has helped Tribe standouts garner 32 All-CAA honors during the last three seasons, highlighted by 14 first-team selections. Additionally, 14 W&M players have combined to earn 45 All-America honors during London's tenure.

In addition to the numerous accolades, London has overseen the development of five former Tribe standouts who have signed NFL contracts – Nate Lynn (Lions), Colby Sorsdal (Lions), Owen Wright (Ravens), Andrew Trainer (Chargers) and Bill Murray (Patriots).

Numerous achievements highlighted the Tribe's most recent campaign last fall. In addition to extending the program's streak of winning seasons and once again appearing in the national polls, five W&M standouts combined to earn 13 All-America honors. Additionally, 10 members of the Tribe garnered All-CAA accolades. Highlighting the impressive group was All-America defensive end Nate Lynn, who signed a free agent contract with the Detroit Lions.

One of the country's top teams defensively, W&M ranked 10th nationally in total defense (303.8), 12th in scoring defense (18.5) and fourth in passing defense (153.5).

Under London's leadership, W&M catapulted to the national forefront in 2022 as it secured a share of the CAA title, earned a No. 5 seed in the NCAA Playoffs and advanced to the NCAA Quarterfinals. Additionally, W&M equaled a school record for wins (11) and posted program records for regular season victories (10) and road triumphs (6). Highlighting the wins were three victories against nationally ranked opponents and a lopsided season-opening triumph at FBS opponent Charlotte.

W&M's success was recognized at the national level, as London was selected as a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, which honors the FCS National Coach of the Year, and finished fourth in the final voting. Additionally, London was selected as the Bobby Ross Coach of the Year by the Touchdown Club of Richmond and the VaSID (Virginia Sports Information Directors) Coach of the Year.

In addition to the team's success, a number of Tribe standouts were recognized with national honors for their outstanding individual contributions. Highlighting an impressive group of six players who earned All-America recognition were linebacker John Pius, offensive lineman Colby Sorsdal and cornerback Jalen Jones. Pius was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award (FCS National Defensive Player of the Year) and finished second in the final voting, while Jones was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award (FCS Freshman of the Year). Sorsdal garnered consensus All-America distinction and was invited to the East-West Shrine Bowl before being selected by the Detroit Lions in the fifth round of the 2023 NFL Draft.

Additionally, 13 Tribe standouts combined to earn 15 all-conference honors, highlighted by a school-record tying seven first-team selections, including the CAA

Defensive Player of the Year, John Pius, and the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year, Jalen Jones.

W&M also rewrote its record book in 2022, as it set single-season school records for rushing yards (3,455), rushing yards per game (265.8) and rushing yards per carry (5.9). Additionally, the Tribe's points per game (33.5), rushing touchdowns (35) and total yards per game (448.8) all ranked among the program's top five

(448.8) all ranked among the program's top five.

Under London's leadership, W&M continued its upward trajectory during the 2021 campaign as it posted the program's most wins since 2015 and garnered a national ranking in multiple weeks. Highlighting the notable victories was a 31-18 road win at No. 4 Villanova.

Individually, seven Tribe standouts earned postseason all-conference honors, highlighted by a pair of All-America standouts in defensive end Nate Lynn, a Buck Buchanan Award Finalist for national defensive player of the year, and left tackle Andrew Trainer, who signed a free agent contract with the Los Angeles Chargers. Additionally, quarterback Darius Wilson was selected as the CAA Offensive Rookie of the Year.

London's first season leading the Tribe provided a glimpse of the program's bright future, as the squad concluded the 2019 campaign with wins in three of its final four games – including a Capital Cup victory at long-time rival Richmond in the season finale. In addition to helping five W&M standouts earn all-conference honors, defensive tackle Bill Murray garnered All-America distinction and signed a free agent contract with the New England Patriots.

London, a former assistant under longtime Tribe head coach Jimmye Laycock, returned to Williamsburg with an impressive list of accomplishments as a head coach that includes winning a national title at the University of Richmond (2008) and earning Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year distinction at the University of Virginia (2011).

Howard University's head coach from 2017-18, London's tenure leading the Bison was highlighted with his selection as a finalist for the 2017 STATS Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Eddie Robinson Award, which is bestowed upon the nation's top head coach. Additionally, he earned the 2017 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Regional Coach of the Year award after guiding Howard to a 6-2 conference record – the program's first winning season since 2012. His inaugural campaign at HU featured a season-opening win at UNLV, which ESPN lauded as one of college football's greatest upsets.

In addition to garnering ACC Coach of the Year honors at UVA in 2011, London led the Cavaliers to the Chick-Fil-A Bowl. En route to earning the postseason bowl bid, he guided UVA to road wins at Miami and Florida State – becoming the first program in the nation to accomplish the feat in the same season.

London gained his first head coaching experience at Richmond, his alma mater, where he amassed a 24-5 record and guided the Spiders to the 2008 FCS national title during his initial campaign. His efforts were recognized by the AFCA, which selected him as the FCS National Coach of the Year. After leading the Spiders to an 8-0 start the following season, UR became just the third FCS school to receive a vote in the AP Poll.
