# **INSIDE THE TRIBE**

### THE GAME

Having posted four consecutive winning seasons, William & Mary will look to continue building upon its success when it opens the 2025 campaign at Furman on Saturday at 2 p.m. The contest will be televised on ESPN+, while a radio broadcast will be available on 92.3 FM The Tide.

### **ABOUT THE TRIBE**

Although W&M enters the 2025 season with a new look at multiple positions, the Tribe boasts a deep and talented roster that should be among the best in the CAA. The offense will be led by OC Winston October, an assistant on W&M's staff from 2014-17 who returns to Williamsburg after building an impressive coaching

resumé with multiple organizations in the CFL and most recently as OC at the University of Richmond. During his three seasons with the Spiders, he helped lead the program to three consecutive NCAA playoff appearances and back-to-back CAA titles. W&M ranked fourth nationally in rushing last season (232.8), marking the fourth-straight year it has ranked among the top 20. Co-defensive coordinators Ras-I Dowling and Bo Revell will lead a talented unit that is highlighted consensus All-America cornerback Jalen Jones and features a league-leading three preseason first-team All-CAA selections.

### SCOUTING THE PALADINS

Picked sixth in the Southern Conference preseason poll, Furman returns 14 starters from last season's squad that posted a 3-8 overall record and a 2-5 mark in conference action. The Paladins are led by five preseason all-conference selections, highlighted by first-team honorees - offensive lineman Eli Brasher, tight end Jackson Pryor, linebacker Ryan Earl, and placekicker Ian Williams. Offensive lineman Luke Petit garnered second team recognition.

### **■ TEAM NOTES**

### **SEASON OPENERS**

W&M will look to secure its fourth consecutive season-opening win when it travels to Furman on Saturday. The Tribe began the last three seasons with victories at Charlotte (2022), at Campbell (2023) and vs. VMI (2024). The Tribe has won those games by an average margin of 20.3, while it has scored 38.7 points per game in those victories.

Excluding the three-game spring season in 2021, W&M has won five of its last six season openers.

### **VERSUS THE SOCON**

After posting a 3-0 mark versus teams from the Southern Conference last season with wins against VMI, Wofford and Furman, W&M boasts an 86-20 all-time record against teams currently in the SoCon.

The Tribe owns winning records against VMI (54-33-2), The Citadel (18-7) and Wofford (4-0), while it is tied in series with Furman (8-8), Chattanooga (1-1) and East Tennessee State (1-1). W&M lost its only meeting versus Samford and has never played Mercer or Western Carolina.

W&M & Mary was a member of the Southern Conference from 1936-1977 and won four league titles (1942, 1947, 1966, 1970).

### **SUCCESS vs. FCS IN NON-CONFERENCE**

W&M has won 44 of its last 46 games against non-conference FCS opponents during the regular season. The lone losses during that span are Lafayette (2012) and Colgate (2018).

Additionally W&M owns a 47-3 record vs. FCS non-conference teams during the regular season dating back through the 2002 season.

### **W&M-FURMAN CONNECTION**

Furman defensive line coach Kevin Lewis served as W&M's defensive line coach from 2014-18.

### WINNING SEASONS

With last season's 7-5 record, W&M secured its fourth consecutive winning season. It marked the first time W&M has accomplished the feat since posting eight straight winning seasons from 1992-99.

# PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Four W&M standouts recently earned preseason All-America honors from various organizations, as cornerback Jalen Jones, offensive lineman Ryan McKenna, linebacker Luke Banbury and fullback/halfback Trey McDonald all garnered national recognition.

### PRESEASON ALL-CAA SELECTIONS

Eight W&M standouts earned preseason all-conference honors this year, as cornerback Jalen Jones, defensive lineman Davin Dzidzienyo, linebacker Luke Banbury, fullback/halfback Trey McDonald and punt returner Carson Jenkins garnered first-team distinction, while tight end Sean McElwain, offensive lineman Ryan McKenna and defensive lineman Ty Gordon earned honorable mention accolades.

The Tribe's three first-team selections on defense were the most of any team in the league.

W&M was picked to finish seventh in the

preseason poll.

Both the preseason all-conference team and preseason poll were selected based on a vote by the CAA's 14 head coaches.

### **CAPTAINS**

Serving as team captains this season are four standouts - DL Davin Dzidzienyo, CB Jalen Jones, TE Trey McDonald and OL Ryan McKenna, who is a two-time team captain.

# TRIBE IN THE NFL

Six former Tribe standouts were in NFL preseason camps this year - offensive lineman Charles Grant (Raiders), linebacker/defensive end Nate Lynn (Lions), All-Pro long snapper Luke Rhodes (Colts), offensive lineman Bill Murray (Bears), offensive lineman Colby Sorsdal (Lions) and running back Owen Wright (Buccaneers).

Additionally, a pair of former Tribe players are currently serving as NFL head coaches - Mike Tomlin '95 (Pittsburgh Steelers, head coach) and Sean McDermott '98 (Buffalo Bills).

New York Giants head coach Brian Daboll was an assistant on W&M's staff in 1997, while Washington Commanders head coach Dan Quinn was an assistant with the Tribe in 1994.

Also noteworthy is a pair of former W&M head coaches who went on to have extraordinary Hall of Fame careers - Marv Levy and Lou Holtz. Levy served as W&M's head coach from 1964-68 and was followed by Holtz from 1969-71.

### **EARLY LEADS**

W&M posted a 4-0 record when it scored first last season and was 6-1 when leading at halftime. Dating back to the 2014 season, the Tribe has won 42 of its last 50 games when leading at halftime.

### **HOLDING ON TO LEADS**

Dating back to the start of the 2013 season, W&M owns a 59-6 record when leading after three quarters.

### **HALFTIME ADJUSTMENTS**

Last season W&M outscored its opponents in the second half, 150-122, which included an impressive 102-50 margin in the fourth quarter.

### **RUSHING TO SUCCESS**

W&M owned a 7-1 record last season when it outgained its opponents on the ground. In those seven victories the Tribe is averaged 295.0 rushing yards per contest.

# 20 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

W&M owns an 40-10 record during the last seven seasons in games in which it scored more than 20 points.

During the last four seasons, W&M is 29-7 in such contests.

### WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

During the last seven seasons, W&M is 25-4 when it commits fewer turnovers than its opponents, while it is 5-18 when it loses the turnover battle during the recent stretch.

### **SUCCESS AT HOME**

W&M finished the 2024 season with a 5-1 record at home and has won 12 of its last 15 games at Zable Stadium during the last three seasons.

### ■ TEAM OFFENSIVE NOTES

### **LEADING THE OFFENSE**

Winston October enters his first season as the Tribe's offensive coordinator after rejoining W&M's staff in January.

An assistant on W&M's staff from 2014-17, October returns to Williamsburg after building an impressive coaching resumé with multiple organizations in the Canadian Football League (CFL) and most recently as offensive coordinator at the University of Richmond. During his three seasons with the Spiders, he helped lead the program to three consecutive NCAA playoff appearances and back-to-back CAA titles.

Under October's leadership as offensive coordinator, which included one year as co-OC in 2023, the Spiders' dynamic offensive attack averaged nearly 28 points per game during the past two seasons and produced numerous all-conference selections, highlighted by five All-CAA honorees in 2024. En route to helping UR total 10 wins and record a perfect 8-0 mark in CAA action last fall, October's group ranked among the top 20 nationally in rushing offense (194.4) and third down conversion percentage (.462). Additionally, after taking over as OC in 2023 he helped the Spiders post a 14-1 mark in CAA play, highlighted by 14 consecutive league wins – the nation's longest active conference winning streak in the FCS.

# **OFFENSIVE LINE**

Although replacing All-America left tackle Charles Grant, who was selected by the Las Vegas Raiders in the third round of last spring's NFL Draft, is noteworthy, all five of the Tribe's projected starters have significant starting experience. Led by all-conference center and two-year team captain Ryan McKenna, this year's group possesses all the ingredients to continue building on the program's tradition of success up front and will look to rank among the nation's top four in rushing for the third time in the past four seasons. Additionally, the Tribe enters the 2025 campaign having ranked among the nation's top 17 in rushing four consecutive years. Jack Armstrong, the OL coach and run game coordinator, will lead the group as he enters his first season in his new role after successfully mentoring the tight ends for the past five years.

### QUARTERBACK

With the graduation of four-year starter and all-conference standout Darius Wilson, the Tribe will have a new signal caller under center for the first time since 2020 when it takes the field this fall. Fortunately for first-year quarterbacks coach Bryan Randall, junior Tyler Hughes provides the squad with an experienced option who has demonstrated the ability to be a dynamic dual-threat force. Hughes displayed his athleticism and dual-threat abilities in last season's win against Hampton, rushing for

130 yards on three carries with two touchdowns. He also rushed for 54 yards on six carries at Coastal Carolina.

### **AMONG THE BEST**

Bolstering W&M's offensive attack this season will be an impressive collection of tight ends, which is among the nation's best. First-year tight ends coach Mike Maloney will lead the group after successful stints with multiple programs, including James Madison, Marshall and VMI. The dynamic group, which is led by a pair of returning all-conference standouts in Trey McDonald and Sean McElwain, provides a number of unique skill sets that should help the offense thrive both through the air and on the ground. McDonald is a team captain and preseason All-America selection, while McElwain totaled 20 catches for 361 yards and five touchdowns in 2024.

### **WIDE RECEIVERS**

A key component to W&M success offensively this season will be production at the wide receiver position, and offensive coordinator/wide receivers coach Winston October is confident this year's unit is poised for an outstanding 2025 campaign. In addition to first-team All-CAA punt returner Carson Jenkins, the unit is headlined by a pair of former transfers who were limited last season with the Tribe – Damian Harris (Bucknell / 104 receptions for 1,151 yds & 5 TD) and Isaiah Lemmond (VMI / 59 receptions for 738 yds) – but were tremendously productive with their former programs and are expected to thrive this fall.

### **RUSHING ATTACK**

Although the graduation of two of the most productive players in school history – Bronson Yoder and Malachi Imoh – is noteworthy, running backs coach Perry Jones has a talented group of standouts who possess the talent and drive to continue W&M's tradition of outstanding play in the offensive backfield. Transfers Tariq Sims (Old Dominion) and Rashad Raymond (VMI, UT Martin) are expected to provide significant production, while a pair of talented underclassmen – Josh Miller and Jor'dyn Whitelaw – are also expected to earn opportunities to produce.

### THIRD DOWN CONVERSIONS

W&M was tremendously successful converting third downs last season and ranked 10th nationally with a .479 conversion percentage.

# **GROUND GAME PRODUCTION IS KEY**

Since joining the CAA in 1993, W&M has rushed for at least 200 yards 109 times and posted an 98-11 record in those contests.

Additionally, W&M is 57-11 when out-rushing the opposition since 2013.

### **STAT TO WATCH**

Dating back through the 2011 season, W&M has struggled to win games in which it has thrown at least 30 passes and owns an 12-26 mark in such contests.



# **■ TEAM DEFENSIVE NOTES**

### IT STARTS UP FRONT

One of W&M's most talented and experienced returning units is defensive line coach Keenan Carter's group. Led by senior captain all-conference standout Davin Dzidzienyo and Ty Gordon, who earned freshman All-America honors last season after transferring from Syracuse, the Tribe's defensive front should be among the nation's best lines this season. The talented group also boasts a pair of standouts with significant starting experience in Gerald Williams and Gent Veizi, while the roster is loaded with additional players who could earn significant reps and make a positive impact.

### **LINEBACKERS**

Led by co-defensive coordinator Bo Revell (inside linebackers), Darryl Blackstock (rush ends) and Kevin Jarrell (field linebackers), the Tribe's linebacking unit will have a new look this season following the graduation of three starters. However, the group, which features a pair of talented grad transfers in preseason All-American Luke Banbury (Cornell ) and Jorden McDonald (Virginia Tech), includes a number of experienced players, highlighted by returners Elijah Rainer, Harrison Johnson and Jaden Boring who all have starting experience.

### **ELITE SECONDARY**

Although the defensive secondary will have a new look this season with three new starters, codefensive coordinator / defensive backs coach Ras-I Dowling is confident this year's talented group of standouts is well equipped to emerge as one of the nation's premier units. Led by All-American and NFL prospect Jalen Jones at cornerback, the secondary features a pair of experienced fifth-year players in Latrelle Smith-Leaks and transfer Aidan Ryan (Virginia), as well as an impressive mix of returning veterans and promising newcomers. The competition for reps should pay dividends in both production and depth as numerous players will have the opportunity to earn significant roles this season

# STRONG FINISHES

W&M's defense was tremendous during the fourth quarter last season and allowed just six touchdowns and 50 points. Villanova was the only team in the CAA to allow fewer points in the fourth quarter (37) during the regular season.

### **BALL HAWKS**

W&M recorded at least one interception in nine consecutive games to conclude the 2024 campaign.

W&M forced at least one turnover in 10 straight games to finish the season, totaling 15 turnovers during that span.

### SHUTTING DOWN THE PASS

Since the start of the 2007 season, a span of 196 games, the Tribe has allowed more than 300 passing yards just 15 times.

### TOUGH TO SCORE THROUGH THE AIR

Since the start of the start of the 2016 season, a span of 94 games, just 32 opponents have scored more than one passing touchdown against W&M.

### **TOUGH DEFENSE AT ZABLE STADIUM**

The Tribe defense has been outstanding in home games since the start of the 2009 season and is allowing just 18.8 points per game at Zable Stadium during the stretch.

During the stretch of 83 games (1,566 points), W&M has posted six shutouts.

W&M is 55-28 at home during that span.

After leading the William & Mary football team to four consecutive winning campaigns for the first time in 25 years, Head Coach Mike London returns for his seventh season at the helm of the Tribe.

W&M ascended as high as No. 10 in the national rankings in 2024, marking the fourth straight season in which the Tribe garnered a national ranking and the third straight year in which it appeared in the top 10.

During the recent stretch of success, London has helped Tribe standouts garner 44 All-CAA honors during the last four seasons, highlighted by 17 first-team selections. Additionally, 17 W&M players have combined to earn 65 All-America honors during London's tenure.

In addition to the numerous accolades, London has overseen the development of six former Tribe standouts who have signed NFL contracts – Charles Grant (Raiders), Nate Lynn (Lions), Colby Sorsdal (Lions), Owen Wright (Ravens), Andrew Trainer (Chargers) and Bill Murray (Patriots).

Numerous achievements highlighted the Tribe's most recent campaign last fall. In addition to extending the program's streak of winning seasons and once again appearing in the national polls, five W&M standouts combined to earn 20 All-America honors – highlighted by offensive lineman Charles Grant, who was a consensus first-team honoree and a third-round draft pick by the Las Vegas Raiders. In addition to Grant, three other standouts earned NFL rookie minicamp invites – Hollis Mathis (Steelers), Marcus Barnes (Bengals) and Matthew Akuchie (Colts) – while 12 members of the Tribe garnered All-CAA accolades.

W&M also continued its tradition of boasting one of the nation's top rushing attacks as it ranked fourth in the country in yards per game on the ground (232.8). Additionally, it marked the second time in the last three seasons W&M ranked among the nation's top four and the fourth-straight year in which it ranked among the top 17.

Members of the squad also excelled in the classroom as 55 standouts earned CAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll recognition during the fall semester.

In 2025 London was honored for the tremendous success on and off the field with the prestigious W&M Plumeri Award, which recognizes and rewards the core values that distinguish outstanding faculty members and coaches who define excellence.

Following a successful 2023 campaign five W&M standouts combined to earn 13 All-America honors, while 10 members of the Tribe garnered All-CAA accolades. Highlighting the impressive group was All-America defensive end Nate Lynn, who signed a free agent contract with the Detroit Lions.

One of the country's top teams defensively, W&M ranked 10th nationally in total defense (303.8), 12th in scoring defense (18.5) and fourth in passing defense (153.5).

Under London's leadership, W&M catapulted to the national forefront in 2022 as it secured a share of the CAA title, earned a No. 5 seed in the NCAA Playoffs and advanced to the NCAA Quarterfinals. Additionally, W&M equaled a school record for wins (11) and posted program records for regular season victories (10) and road triumphs (6). Highlighting the wins were three victories against nationally ranked opponents and a lopsided season-

opening triumph at FBS opponent Charlotte.

W&M's success was recognized at the national level, as London was selected as a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, which honors the FCS National Coach of the Year, and finished fourth in the final voting. Additionally, London was selected as the Bobby Ross Coach of the Year by the Touchdown Club of Richmond and the VaSID (Virginia Sports Information Directors) Coach of the Year.

In addition to the team's success, a number of Tribe standouts were recognized with national honors for their outstanding individual contributions. Highlighting an impressive group of six players who earned All-America recognition were linebacker John Pius, offensive lineman Colby Sorsdal and cornerback Jalen Jones. Pius was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award (FCS National Defensive Player of the Year) and finished second in the final voting, while Jones was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award (FCS Freshman of the Year). Sorsdal garnered consensus All-America distinction and was invited to the East-West Shrine Bowl before being selected by the Detroit Lions in the fifth round of the 2023 NFL Draft.

Additionally, 13 Tribe standouts combined to earn 15 all-conference honors, highlighted by a school-record tying seven first-team selections, including the CAA Defensive Player of the Year, John Pius, and the CAA Defensive Rookie of the Year, Jalen Jones.

W&M also rewrote its record book in 2022, as it set single-season school records for rushing yards (3,455), rushing yards per game (265.8) and rushing yards per carry (5.9). Additionally, the Tribe's points per game (33.5), rushing touchdowns (35) and total yards per game (448.8) all ranked among the program's top five. Defensively, W&M's 33 sacks also ranked as the seventh-best total in school history.

London, a former assistant under longtime Tribe head coach Jimmye Laycock, returned to Williamsburg with an impressive list of accomplishments as a head coach that includes winning a national title at the University of Richmond (2008) and earning Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year distinction at the University of Virginia (2011).

Howard University's head coach from 2017-18, London's tenure leading the Bison was highlighted with his selection as a finalist for the 2017 STATS Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Eddie Robinson Award, which is bestowed upon the nation's top head coach. Additionally, he earned the 2017 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Regional Coach of the Year award after guiding Howard to a 6-2 conference record – the program's first winning season since 2012. His inaugural campaign at HU featured a season-opening win at UNLV, which ESPN lauded as one of college football's greatest upsets.

Prior to his two-year stint at HU, London served as an associate head coach/defensive line coach at the University of Maryland in 2016 where he helped lead the Terps to an appearance in the Quick Lane Bowl.

In addition to garnering ACC Coach of the Year honors at UVA in 2011, London led the Cavaliers to the Chick-Fil-A Bowl. En route to earning the postseason bowl bid, he guided UVA to road wins at Miami and Florida State – becoming the first program in the nation to accomplish the feat in the same season.
