**BLACKSBURG, VA.** - Virginia Tech scored the final nine points of the first half in opening up a double-digits lead and shot 55.7 percent for the game in downing the Tribe, 85-79, in the opening round of the National Invitation Tournament inside Cassel Coliseum.

Keith Cieplicki and Brant Weidner led the way for the Green and Gold with 23 and 21 points, respectively. Cieplicki connected on 10-of-20 from the floor, while Weidner was 10-of-16 and just missed a double-double with a team-best eight rebounds. Kevin Richards added 10 points, five rebounds and four assists to go with eight points and five rebounds from Matt Brooks off the bench.

Cieplicki and Weidner combined for 20 of the Tribe's first 26 points as W&M opened up a 26-20 lead with 7:42 left in the opening half. The Hokies responded with a 15-2 run over the final four and a half minutes of the first period to take a double-digit halftime lead. Included in the final spurt, Virginia Tech scored the half's last nine points over the final 1:09.

The Tribe drew within five points, 51-46, on a Weidner jumper with 12:49 remaining, but the Hokies again answered with a run. Virginia Tech scored nine of the game's next 10 points capped by a Perry Young three-point play at the 9:26 mark pushed the lead to 60-47.

Virginia Tech shot better than 55 percent in each half, finishing at 55.7 (34-of-61) and added a 17-of-21 (81 percent) from the free throw line. The Hokies dished out 23 assists, blocked nine shots and outrebounded the Tribe, 36-32. W&M finished the contest at 48.6 percent (34-of-70) from the floor and connected on 68.8 percent (11-of-16) from the free throw line.

Young led five Hokies in double figures with 19 points. Reggie Streppe tallied 18 points off the bench, while Dell Curry poured in 14 points and dished out a game-high eight assists. Bobby Beecher scored 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting to go with four blocked shots and Keith Colbert added 10 points, seven rebounds and four assists.

**CHAPEL HILL, N.C.** - The Tribe hit a school-record 16 3-pointers and led 72-69 with five minutes remaining, but North Carolina scored the game's final 11 points, including nine from the free throw line, to pick up an 80-72 win at Carmichael Arena.

Senior guard David Schneider led the 3-point arsenal with 21 points on 7-of-15 from 3-point range to go along with a career-high eight assists. Sophomore forward JohnMark Ludwick drilled five 3-pointers to finish with 15 points in his first start for the Tribe in the place of second-leading scorer and All-CAA player Quinn McDowell, who was out due to injury. Senior wing Danny Sumner wrapped up his career with a 13-point night, while junior forward Marcus Kitts tallied 12 points and five rebounds. Senior Steven Hess scored six points and pulled down a team-high seven rebounds, while fellow classmate Sean McCurdy dished out six assists.

W&M trailed 43-33 at the half, but came out of the gates firing in the second stanza. The College opened the second frame on an 11-2 run highlighted by a trio of 3-pointers. Ludwick hit back-to-back 3-pointers, before a triple from Schneider at the 17:19 mark cut the deficit to 45-44.

The College finally tied the game at 55 on a spinning jumper in the lane from Hess at the 13:16 mark. A pair of free throws from sophomore guard Kendrix Brown put the College back on top for the first time since early in the first half, before an alley-oop dunk by Sumner gave W&M a 59-55 lead with 11:53 left.

Four straight Tyler Zeller points, including a steal and fast-break dunk, put Carolina on top, 69-66, with 6:17 remaining. On the ensuing W&M possession, Ludwick found Sumner for a 3-pointer to knot things at 69. After a stop on the defensive end, Schneider dialed up long distance from the right wing to give the College a 72-69 lead with 5:09 remaining.

W&M had a pair of chances on its next two possession to extend the lead, but neither open 3-point look would fall. The Tar Heels regained the lead for good on four straight free throws from Dexter Strickland. His final two freebies made it 73-72 with 2:34 remaining. W&M could not find the mark the rest of the way, and Carolina hit 9-of-12 from the free throw line to pull out the victory.

W&M finished the game shooting 41.9 percent (26-of-62) from the field and 37.2 percent (16-of-43) from 3-point range. The Tribe's 16 3-pointers tied the school record. The College assisted on 22 of its 26 made field goals, including 20 of its first 21 made shots from the floor. UNC shot 49.1 percent (28-of-57) from the field and hit on 18-of-26 from the free throw line. Deon Thompson led UNC with 20 points on 9-of-13 shooting to go along with eight rebounds. Zeller finished with 13 points, while Marcus Ginyard rounded out the double-digit scorers with 12 points.

**TULSA, OKLA.** - On display numerous times in 2014-15, that never quit attitude of the William and Mary men's basketball team did not stop on Tuesday night, the Tribe just ran out of time in a 70-67 loss at Tulsa in the opening round of the National Invitation Tournament. Trailing by as many as 21 points with 13:07 remaining, W&M (20-13) drew to as close as two points and had a pair of chances from 3-point range to tie it in the closing 15 seconds, but on each occasion, the shot was off the mark.

One of the greatest careers in W&M history came to a close as senior guard Marcus Thornton led the Tribe with a game-high 23 points, including 17 in the second half. Sophomore Omar Prewitt tallied his first career double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds, while junior Terry Tarpey finished with another all-around stat line of 14 points, six rebounds and five assists.

Tulsa (23-10) used a 23-4 run, spanning the final 1:08 of the first half and opening 6:53 of the second half, to open up a 21-point lead. In total, the Golden Hurricane scored the final five points of the first 20 minutes and the first nine points of the second half. James Woodard scored four straight points of the second half, pushing the TU lead to double-digits for the first time and forcing a W&M timeout just over a minute into the period. Five straight Marquel Curtis points extended the lead to 19 points, before its reaches it largest at 57-36 with 13:07 remaining.

W&M showed its ability to score quickly, putting together a 10-1 run in less than two minutes. Prewitt knocked down a 3-pointer, before Thornton hit a step-back jumper. Tarpey scored the final five points of the run, including and old-fashion three-point play after a steal to draw the Tribe within 58-46 at 11:14 mark.

A Thornton 3-pointer cut the deficit to 64-56 with 7:38 remaining, but the margin was 10 with five minutes to play after a Rashad Smith lay-up. Tarpey answered on the ensuing Tribe possession, hitting a 3-pointer to ignite a seven-point W&M run. The Tribe closed the gap to three, 66-63, on a pair of Sean Sheldon free throws with 1:50 left.

W&M scored four straight points to draw within two with just 27 seconds remaining. The Tribe had two chances to tie the game in the final 20 seconds, but Thornton and Tarpey missed game-tying 3-point attempts and Tulsa hung on for the win.

W&M shot a just 33.8 percent (22-of-65) from the field, but connected on 11 3-pointers. Despite being outrebounded, 41-36, the Green and Gold pulled down 17 offensive rebounds and also added eight steals. Tulsa finished the contest at 48.2 percent (27-of-56) shooting, including 8-of-20 from 3-point range. Curtis led TU with 21 points, while James Woodard tallied a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds.
