13.8	With three straight games of single-digit turnovers, W&M ranks 57th in the NCAA and first in the CAA with 13.8 turnovers per game.
21.3	W&M is forcing its opponents into 21.3 turnovers a game, which leads the CAA and ranks 44th in the NCAA. Its 7.5 turnover margin is good for 24th nationally.
56	W&M's seniors Victoria Reynolds and Ashley Taylor have 56 career wins, which are just 10 shy of tying the school for winningest class in school history with 66.
70	70 seems to be a magic number under Swanson. W&M has reached that mark 54 times under Swanson, and has posted a 44-10 when accomplishing that feat.
82%	W&M is leading the CAA and ranks third nationally with an 82.0-percent free throw percentage. The Tribe has hit 73-of-its-89 attempts from the line.
93.8%	Since the start of CAA play last season, sophomore Eva Hodgson has connected on 72-of-77 from the free throw line for 93.5%
100	W&M has passed out 100 assists this season, which leads the CAA and ranks 39th in the NCAA. Its 16.7 helpers a game also ranks best in the league.
141	Senior Victoria Reynolds is just 141 points away from becoming the 21st W&M player to score 1,000 career points.

### **W&M NEWS & NOTES**

- William & Mary returns to action as it hits the road to take on Delaware State on Saturday, Nov. 30. The matinee tips off at 2 p.m. at Memorial Hall in Dover, Del.
- The Tribe and Delaware State meet for the seventh time in series history on Saturday afternoon. W&M has won the previous six meetings, including the last meet and trip to Delaware State. That night, the Tribe picked up an 82-48 victory on Nov. 28, 2016.
- For the fourth time in the last five seasons, W&M has started the season 5-1. The Green and Gold improved to 6-1 in each of the previous three attempts.
- Despite scoring a season-low 61 points on Tuesday night against Hartford, W&M still leads the CAA and ranks 85th in the country averaging 73.8 points per contest. W&M has eclipsed the 70-point mark in five of its first six games.
- W&M is also off to a great start shooting the basketball as it leads the CAA and ranks 73rd in the country shooting 44.1-percent from the field. The Tribe has shot better than 40-percent in four of its six games.
- Freshman Bre Bellamy earned the Tribe's first weekly award honor as she was named the CAA Rookie of the Week for the week of Nov. 25 averaging 8.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game. Sophomore Eva Hodgson was also honored by the league as the honorable mention player of the week after averaging a league-best 22.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 3.0 assists.
- Hodgson continues her hot start to the season as she has been the Tribe's leading scorer in all five games. After scoring the most points in the Division I era in a season opener (27), Hodgson reset her career-high with 29 points at Richmond. She is averaging 19.2 points per game, 4.7 rebounds, and 3.5 assists. The sophomore also leads the CAA and ranks 28th in the country with 18 steals.
- Furthermore, Hodgson is one of seven players national (as of Nov. 29) to be perfect from the free-throw line this season, as she has connected on her first 25 from the free throw. Dating to back to March 1 of last season, Hodgson has hit 35 consecutive from the free-throw line.
- Starting with her third career double-double at ECU, senior Victoria Reynolds has been in double-figures in three of the last four games. In the game against the Pirates, she recorded season-highs with 17 points, 12 rebounds, and six steals. A Preseason All-CAA Honorable Mention selection, Reynolds is averaging 11.7 points per game and 4.8 rebounds a night. She has been in double-figures in 42 career games and needs 141 more points to become the 21st player in school history with 1,000 career points.
- Bellamy, who is the reigning CAA Rookie of the Week, became the third straight true freshman to earn an opening night start at Army in the opener. During coach Swanson's tenure with the Tribe, he has started at least one true freshman in five of the seven seasons he has been the coach. The rookie has been in double-figures three times, including the last two games and is averaging 8.8 points, 3.0 rebounds, and 1.3 steals per game.
- Junior Bailey Eichner has enjoyed her enhanced role during her junior campaign and is off to a career start. Eichner first scored a career-high 11 points in the win at East Carolina, before adding a career-high eight rebounds at Richmond. The Cudahy, Wisc. native has been the first Tribe post player off of the bench in each contest, and in her new role is averaging 4.7 points, and a team-high 5.2 rebounds, 1.0 assists, and 0.8 steals per game. During the last three contests, the junior is averaging 7.0 rebounds a game.
- Redshirt sophomore, transfer Sydney Wagner hasn't missed a beat after having to sit out last year due to NCAA transfer rules. Coming off the bench, she is averaging 9.8 points per game and 2.0 3-pointers per contest.
- A constant in the Tribe lineup since starting her Tribe career, junior Nyla Pollard ranks eighth in the country and leads the CAA with a 4.60 assist-to-turnover ratio. Pollard is tied for a teambest 19 assists, while only having four miscues this season. Pollard, who will make her 51st career start tonight, is averaging 6.0 points per game and is coming off a season-high 10 points against Hartford.
- W&M head coach Ed Swanson became the 69th head coach in Division I history to win his 500th career game on Tuesday night against Hartford. The win also pushed him back to .500 winning percentage at W&M (94-94). With six more wins, he will become just the third coach in W&M women's basketball history to win more than 100 games.

Ed Swanson enters his sixth season with the Green and Gold. He became the fifth Division I head women's basketball coach in William and Mary history on May 7, 2013. Prior to coming to Williamsburg, he spent 23 years transforming Sacred Heart University from a Division II program into a one of the top teams in the Northeast Conference. Swanson owns a career record of 495-356 (.582).

For the fifth straight season, a first in W&M history, the Tribe won 15 games and advanced to the CAA Quarterfinals in the 2018-19 season. Senior Bianca Boggs continued her assualt on the W&M record books as she finished her career with 1,455 points, which ranks xx in school history, while her single-season 530 points was a new school record. For her efforts she was named to the All-CAA First-Team for the second straight season. Swanson also guided freshman Eva Hodgson to CAA Rookie of the Year honors, making her the second player in his time at W&M to win the award. Hodgson finished the seaosn avearging 10.2 points and 3.0 assists per contest. The senior class - Boggs, Misha Jones, and Chandler Smith - tied the school record for winningest senior class with 66 victories.

The success continued for the Tribe during the 2017-18 season. W&M won 16 games, which is tied for the fourth most in school history, and posted its second straight winning season for the first time since 2005-06 and 2006-07. His first recruiting class became the winningest class in school history with the team's victory over College of Charleston on Jan. 26. The seniors went onto win 66 games during their four year career. The Tribe raced out to an 11-2 start for the third straight season, which equaled the best 13-game start in school history, and led the CAA in blocked shots (218) and blocked shots per game (7.3), which ranked fourth and third in the NCAA, respectively. Both numbers are single-season school records. Individually, he mentored three players to five All-CAA awards, including All-CAA First-Team selection Bianca Boggs, who became the first Tribe player in a decade to be named to the league's first-team. Additionally, Boggs was named to the league's all-defensive team, while Abby Rendle claimed a spot on the All-ČAA Third-Team, and All-Defensive Team, and freshman Nyla Pollard was picked to the CAA All-Rookie team.

Swanson led the Tribe to one of its best seasons in program history in 2016-17. The Tribe tied a school record with 20 wins, while winning a CAA Tournament game for the first time since 2009, and advancing to the CAA Semifinals for the first-time since 2001. Under his leadership, the Tribe won 11-straight games, which is the longest single-23056season streak in school history, from Nov. 18, 2016-Jan. 2, 2017. W&M had four players claim seven all-conference awards this season, including seniors Alexandra Masaquel and Marlena Tremba, who each earned secondteam citations. Additionally, Masaquel was tabbed the Richmond Times-Dispatch All-State Second-Team, while Tremba earned VaSID All-State Second-Team honors. For his efforts, VaSID honored him as the Virginia State Coach of the Year.

Once again Swanson's third season was one for the record books. The Tribe raced out to its best start in school history with an 11-2 record. W&M went onto again to win the fourth most wins in school history with 15. For the second straight season the Tribe broke the blocks and assist record, by tying the single season assist record (466) and broke the school record for blocks with 148. During the season junior Marlena Tremba became the 15th player in school history to break the 1000-point barrier. Individually, four players earned All-CAA awards as junior Alexandra Masaguel was tabbed to the second-team and all-defensive team, Tremba eared third-team honors, and freshman Bianca Boggs picked up a spot on the all-rookie team. The Tribe was also rewarded for its hard work in the classroom as Masaquel, Tremba, and sophomore Jenna Green earned all-academic team honors.

Swanson's second year with the Green and Gold was one for the record books. The Tribe racked up 15 wins, the fourth-most in school history, on its way to its first-ever postseason appearances with bid in the Women's Basketball Invitational. The Green and Gold had a seven-win turnaround, while setting three school records for assists (466), blocked shots, (143), blocked shots per game (4.5). Individually he helped lead four players to five All-CAA awards. Sophomore Marlena Tremba was named to the All-CAA Third-Team, senior Jazmen Boone was named to the All-Defensive Team, freshman Abby Rendle to the All-Rookie and All-Defensive team, and senior Kyla Kerstetter earned all-academic honors.

In his first season with the Tribe, Swanson led a young team to eight victories in a seven-seed in the CAA Tournament. The Green and Gold finished in the top 10 nationally in steals per game, while Jazmen Boone also ranked in the top 20 in the NCAA in the same category. Under his



guidance Kaitlyn Mathieu garnered Third-Team All-Colonial Athletic Association honors, and went on to sign a professional contract with a team in Germany. In addition, quard Marlena Tremba went onto win CAA Rookie of the Year, and was named to the all-rookie squad. Boone was named to the all-defensive team, while she and Kyla Kerstetter took home all-academic honors.

Swanson oversaw Sacred Heart's transition from Division II to Division I in 1999-00, and the program took off under his direction. Over Sacred Heart's 14 years in Division I, Swanson led SHU to a 280-145 record (.664), including a 190-62 (.754) record in the NEC. He departed as the NEC's all-time winningest head coach with all of his SHU teams finishing third or higher in the league standings. Swanson-lead teams have posted 13 straight winning seasons and 12 straight campaigns with 18 or more victories, including six with 20 or more wins. In 2009, he was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame.

In total, Swanson-coached players earned 19 All-NEC honors, including nine first-team awards, nine NEC All-Tournament Team honors, eight NEC All-Rookie Team selections, four NEC Rookies of the Year, three NEC Tournament MVPs and three NEC Players of the Year.

His teams have also enjoyed success in the classroom. On five occasions, the Pioneers were selected to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll, which has recognized outstanding academic performances from the top teams in each of the five collegiate divisions since 1995-96. On eight occasions since 2003, one of his players was a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection and two Pioneer players were named NEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

In 2012-13, Swanson led Sacred Heart to its third straight postseason appearance, and in the process, recorded his 400th career victory. His milestone win came on Feb. 12, 2013 as the Pioneers defeated Fairleigh Dickinson. SHU completed the season at 22-11, finishing second in the NEC with a 13-5 ledger and garnering a berth in the program's first Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT).

Sacred Heart claimed its third NEC Championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2011-12. The Pioneers also ranked 23rd nationally in the WBCA Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll with a team GPA of 3.35. SHU compiled a season mark to 25-8, winning both the regular season and postseason crowns in the league as Swanson was named NEC Coach of the Year for the fourth time.

The Pioneers earned a berth in the 2011 Women's Basketball Invitational Swanson took the reins of the Sacred Heart University and finished the year at 18-13 with a 12-6 mark in the NEC. 
