W&M NEWS & NOTES

- The William & Mary women's basketball team closes a stretch of three games in seven days as it begins a two-game road swing against former CAA rivals at East Carolina on Tuesday night. Tip time between the Tribe and the Pirates is set for 7
- W&M and ECU meet for the 48th time in series history and for the fourth consecutive season. The Pirates lead the all-time series 33-14, but W&M has won the last four meetings. The Green and Gold topped ECU at Kaplan Arena last year 63-43, and won a thriller 71-65 in overtime in its last visit to Minges Coliseum.
- For the ninth time in the Division I era, which started in 1981-82, W&M has begun the season off 2-0. It is the third time under head coach Ed Swanson that the Tribe is 2-0. W&M has only started 3-0 one time in that span, which was 1987-88.
- Sophomore Eva Hodgson has gotten off to a hot start to the 2019-20 season. The team's leading scorer, she is averaging 21.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, and 3.5 assists. She set a modern-era school record as she scored 27 points, which was the most in a season-opener and her career-high, against Army. All-time, the most points in a season opener was 30 by Mar-C Million in 1963.
- Freshman Bre Bellamy became the third straight true freshman to earn an opening night start on Tuesday night at Army. During coach Swanson's tenure with the Tribe, he has started at least one true freshman in five of the seven seasons he has been the coach. The rookie was in double-figures for the first time against Maryland Eastern Shore with 11 points. She's currently tied for third on the team averaging 9.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game.
- Redshirt sophomore, transfer Sydney Wagner hasn't missed a beat after having to sit out last year due to NCAA transfer rules. Coming off of the bench and both contests, she averaging 13.0 points per game and 3.0 3-pointers per contest.
- Swanson needs just three more career victories to claim the 500th of his career. He is currently 32nd among active head coaches with 496 wins and will become 69th Division I head coach to reach that mark.
- Despite losing two-time All-CAA First-Team selection Bianca Boggs to graduation, W&M still returns four starters from last year's roster, including double-figure scorers senior Victoria Reynolds and sophomore Eva Hodgson. Furthermore, the Tribe returns 67-percent of its points, 57-percent of rebounds, and 57.5-percent of its assists from last season.
- W&M was selected to finish seventh in the CAA Preseason Poll by a vote of the league's head coaches. Last year's regular-season champions James Madison was picked as the preseason favorite, while Drexel was picked second, and 2019 CAA Champions Towson was picked third.
- Senior Victoria Reynolds garnered a Preseason All-CAA Honorable Mention citation the league announced during the league's digital media day. Reynolds has averaged double-figures the last two seasons. She appeared in 31 games with 27 starts last season scoring 338 points (10.9 ppg.), 164 rebounds (5.3 rpg), 71 assists, 21 blocks, and 40 steals. For her career, she has appeared in 89 games with 57 starts, 789 points (8.9), 654 rebounds (5.2 reb.), and 152 assists. Reynolds has been in double-figures in 39 career games, including 20 a season ago.
- W&M has won at least 15 games in each of the last five seasons, which is the longest such streak in school history. The Tribe posted back-to-back winning seasons in 2016-17 and 2017-18, which included tying a school record with 20 wins in the 16-17 campaign.

SWANSON

Ed Swanson enters his sixth season with the Green and Gold. He became the fifth Division I head women's basketball coach in William and Mary history on May 7, 2013. Prior to coming to Williamsburg, he spent 23 years transforming Sacred Heart University from a Division II program into a one of the top teams in the Northeast Conference. Swanson owns a career record of 495-356 (.582).

For the fifth straight season, a first in W&M history, the Tribe won 15 games and advanced to the CAA Quarterfinals in the 2018-19 season. Senior Bianca Boggs continued her assualt on the W&M record books as she finished her career with 1,455 points, which ranks xx in school history, while her single-season 530 points was a new school record. For her efforts she was named to the All-CAA First-Team for the second straight season. Swanson also guided freshman Eva Hodgson to CAA Rookie of the Year honors, making her the second player in his time at W&M to win the award. Hodgson finished the seaosn avearging 10.2 points and 3.0 assists per contest. The senior class - Boggs, Misha Jones, and Chandler Smith - tied the school record for winningest senior class with 66 victories.

The success continued for the Tribe during the 2017-18 season. W&M won 16 games, which is tied for the fourth most in school history, and posted its second straight winning season for the first time since 2005-06 and 2006-07. His first recruiting class became the winningest class in school history with the team's victory over College of Charleston on Jan. 26. The seniors went onto win 66 games during their four year career. The Tribe raced out to an 11-2 start for the third straight season, which equaled the best 13-game start in school history, and led the CAA in blocked shots (218) and blocked shots per game (7.3), which ranked fourth and third in the NCAA, respectively. Both numbers are single-season school records. Individually, he mentored three players to five All-CAA awards, including All-CAA First-Team selection Bianca Boggs, who became the first Tribe player in a decade to be named to the league's first-team. Additionally, Boggs was named to the league's all-defensive team, while Abby Rendle claimed a spot on the All-CAA Third-Team, and All-Defensive Team, and freshman Nyla Pollard was picked to the CAA All-Rookie team.

Swanson led the Tribe to one of its best seasons in program history in 2016-17. The Tribe tied a school record with 20 wins, while winning a CAA Tournament game for the first time since 2009, and advancing to the CAA Semifinals for the first-time since 2001. Under his leadership, the Tribe won 11-straight games, which is the longest single-23056season streak in school history, from Nov. 18, 2016-Jan. 2, 2017. W&M had four players claim seven all-conference awards this season, including seniors Alexandra Masaquel and Marlena Tremba, who each earned second-team citations. Additionally, Masaquel was tabbed the Richmond Times-Dispatch All-State Second-Team, while Tremba earned VaSID All-State Second-Team honors. For his efforts, VaSID honored him as the Virginia State Coach of the Year.

Once again Swanson's third season was one for the record books. The Tribe raced out to its best start in school history with an 11-2 record. W&M went onto again to win the fourth most wins in school history with 15. For the second straight season the Tribe broke the blocks and assist record, by tying the single season assist record (466) and broke the school record for blocks with 148. During the season junior Marlena Tremba became the 15th player in school history to break the 1000-point barrier. Individually, four players earned All-CAA awards as junior Alexandra Masaquel was tabbed to the second-team and all-defensive team, Tremba eared third-team honors, and freshman Bianca Boggs picked up a spot on the all-rookie team. The Tribe was also rewarded for its hard work in the classroom as Masaquel, Tremba, and sophomore Jenna Green earned all-academic team honors.

Swanson's second year with the Green and Gold was one for the record books. The Tribe racked up 15 wins, the fourth-most in school history, on its way to its first-ever postseason appearances with bid in the Women's Basketball Invitational. The Green and Gold had a seven-win turnaround, while setting three school records for assists (466), blocked shots, (143), blocked shots per game (4.5). Individually he helped lead four players to five All-CAA awards. Sophomore Marlena Tremba was named to the All-CAA Third-Team, senior Jazmen Boone was named to the All-Defensive Team, freshman Abby Rendle to the All-Rookie and All-Defensive team, and senior Kyla Kerstetter earned all-academic honors.

In his first season with the Tribe, Swanson led a young team to eight victories in a seven-seed in the CAA Tournament. The Green and Gold finished in the top 10 nationally in steals per game, while Jazmen Boone also ranked in the top 20 in the NCAA in the same category. Under his



guidance Kaitlyn Mathieu garnered Third-Team All-Colonial Athletic Association honors, and went on to sign a professional contract with a team in Germany. In addition, guard Marlena Tremba went onto win CAA Rookie of the Year, and was named to the all-rookie squad. Boone was named to the all-defensive team, while she and Kyla Kerstetter took home all-academic honors.

Swanson oversaw Sacred Heart's transition from Division II to Division I in 1999-00, and the program took off under his direction. Over Sacred Heart's 14 years in Division I, Swanson led SHU to a 280-145 record (.664), including a 190-62 (.754) record in the NEC. He departed as the NEC's all-time winningest head coach with all of his SHU teams finishing third or higher in the league standings. Swanson-lead teams have posted 13 straight winning seasons and 12 straight campaigns with 18 or more victories, including six with 20 or more wins. In 2009, he was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame.

In total, Swanson-coached players earned 19 All-NEC honors, including nine first-team awards, nine NEC All-Tournament Team honors, eight NEC All-Rookie Team selections, four NEC Rookies of the Year, three NEC Tournament MVPs and three NEC Players of the Year.

His teams have also enjoyed success in the classroom. On five occasions, the Pioneers were selected to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll, which has recognized outstanding academic performances from the top teams in each of the five collegiate divisions since 1995-96. On eight occasions since 2003, one of his players was a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection and two Pioneer players were named NEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

In 2012-13, Swanson led Sacred Heart to its third straight postseason appearance, and in the process, recorded his 400th career victory. His milestone win came on Feb. 12, 2013 as the Pioneers defeated Fairleigh Dickinson. SHU completed the season at 22-11, finishing second in the NEC with a 13-5 ledger and garnering a berth in the program's first Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT).

Sacred Heart claimed its third NEC Championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2011-12. The Pioneers also ranked 23rd nationally in the WBCA Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll with a team GPA of 3.35. SHU compiled a season mark to 25-8, winning both the regular season and postseason crowns in the league as Swanson was named NEC Coach of the Year for the fourth time.

The Pioneers earned a berth in the 2011 Women's Basketball Invitational Swanson took the reins of the Sacred Heart University and finished the year at 18-13 with a 12-6 mark in the NEC.
