W&M head coach Ed Swanson needs just two more career victories to claim the 500th of his career.

54

W&M's seniors Victoria Reynolds and Ashley Taylor have 54 career wins, which are just 12 shy of tying the winningest class in school history with 66 victories.

70

70 seems to be a magic number under Swanson. W&M has reached that mark 52 times under Swanson, and has posted a 43-9 when accomplishing that feat.

For the first-time in school history, W&M has scored, at least, 77 points in its first three games. The 77.7 points per game leads the CAA.

## W&amp;M NEWS &amp; NOTES

• Following an eight-day layoff, the William & Mary women's basketball team returns to action to close a two-game road trip against former CAA rivals as it travels up I-64 West to take on Richmond on Wednesday, Nov. 20. Tip time between the Tribe and the Spiders from the Robins Center is set for 6:30 p.m.

• The oldest rivalry in school history, Richmond and W&M play for the 113th time on Wednesday night. Richmond leads the all-time series by an 83-28-1 clip, however, the Tribe has won the last three meetings. The schools have met each of the past five seasons in a series that dates back to the Tribe's first-ever game on Feb. 24, 1920.

• W&M is 3-0 for the first time under head coach Ed Swanson, while the Tribe is 3-0 for just the second time since the Division I era started in 1981-82. The only other year the Tribe started with wins its first three games in that span was 1987-88. Despite being 4-0 eight times in the program's lore, W&M has never been 4-0 in the Division I era and hasn't started 4-0 since 1933-34.

• For the first time in school history, W&M has scored, at least, 77 points in its first three games. The 77.7 points per game lead the CAA and rank 65th nationally. It is the second-best through three games in school history, as the Tribe scored 86.3 points per game in 1993-94.

• Sophomore Eva Hodgson has gotten off to a hot start to the 2019-20 season as she has led the Tribe in scoring in the first three games. The team's leading scorer is averaging 20.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 4.3 assists. Hodgson set a modern-era school record as she scored 27 points, which was the most in a season-opener and her career-high, against Army. All-time, the most points in a season opener were 30 by Mar-C Million in 1963.

• Furthermore, Hodgson is one of 23 players national (as of Nov. 18) to be perfect from the free-throw line this season as she has connected on her first 17 from the free throw. Dating to back to March 1 of last season, Hodgson has hit 27 consecutive from the free-throw line.

• Senior Victoria Reynolds recorded her third career double-double in the win against the Pirates. She posted season-highs with 17 points, 12 rebounds, and six steals. A Preseason All-CAA Honorable Mention selection, Reynolds is averaging 11.7 points per game and leads the team with 7.0 rebounds a night. She has been in double-figures in 40 career games and needs 174 more points to become the 21st player in school history with 1,000 career points.

• Junior Bailey Eichner had a career night in the win last Tuesday night at East Carolina. She turned a career-high 11 points with three rebounds, three assists, and a steal in a career-best 20 minutes. The Cudahy, Wisc. native has been the first Tribe post player off of the bench in each contest, and her new role is averaging 5.7 points, 3.3 rebounds, an assist, a steal per contest.

• Freshman Bre Bellamy became the third straight true freshman to earn an opening night start at Army in the opener. During coach Swanson's tenure with the Tribe, he has started at least one true freshman in five of the seven seasons he has been the coach. The rookie was in double-figures for the first time against Maryland Eastern Shore with 11 points. She's averaging 9.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game.

• Redshirt sophomore, transfer Sydney Wagner hasn't missed a beat after having to sit out last year due to NCAA transfer rules. Coming off the bench, she is averaging 13.3 points per game and 3.0 3-pointers per contest.

• Swanson needs just two more career victories to claim the 500th of his career. He is currently 32nd among active head coaches with 498 wins and will become 69th or 70th Division I head coach to reach that mark. Scott Rueck at Oregon State is at 497 career wins, but the Beavers only play once this week.

	<b>NOV. 26</b>	<b>HARTFORD</b>	<b>5 PM</b>	For the second straight season Hartford and W&M meet. The Hawks won the only previous meeting 50-45 last season in Connecticut.
	Nov. 30	at Delaware State	2 PM	Following Thanksgiving, W&M travels to Delaware State for the seventh meeting in series history. The Tribe is 6-0 vs. the Hornets, including an 82-48 victory in 2016.
	<b>DEC. 5</b>	<b>OLD DOMINION</b>	<b>7 PM</b>	The Green and Gold welcome Old Dominion for the 95th meeting in program history. ODU leads the series 72-22, including an 83-69 victory last season in Norfolk.
	Dec. 8	at VCU	2 PM	W&M plays its fourth former CAA rival when it heads to RVA for the second time this season. VCU and W&M have met 121 times with the Rams leading 82-39.
	<b>DEC. 20</b>	<b>NORFOLK STATE</b>	<b>12 PM</b>	After a 12-day lay-off for finals, W&M hosts Norfolk State for the first-ever Tomorrow's Tribe Education Day. The Tribe leads the series with NSU 15-8, and won 55-44 last season.
	Dec. 29	at George Washington	2 PM	The Tribe meets GW 22nd time in series history in the non-conference finale. W&M leads the series 11-10 thanks to a 73-59 victory in the meeting last year.
	Jan. 3	at James Madison*	7 PM	W&M opens 2020 and CAA play at James Madison. The Tribe is 4-2 under head coach Ed Swanson in CAA openers, including a 69-59 win in Williamsburg over JMU in 2016.
	Jan. 5	at Towson*	2 PM	The Tribe closes the weekend road trip at defending CAA Champion Towson. Last season, the Green and Gold picked up an 80-69 victory at SECU Arena.
	<b>JAN. 10</b>	<b>UNCW*</b>	<b>7 PM</b>	W&M has its CAA home opener against UNCW. The Tribe leads the series with UNCW 36-34, including a 70-64 victory last year in Kaplan.

Ed Swanson enters his sixth season with the Green and Gold. He became the fifth Division I head women's basketball coach in William and Mary history on May 7, 2013. Prior to coming to Williamsburg, he spent 23 years transforming Sacred Heart University from a Division II program into one of the top teams in the Northeast Conference. Swanson owns a career record of 495-356 (.582).

For the fifth straight season, a first in W&M history, the Tribe won 15 games and advanced to the CAA Quarterfinals in the 2018-19 season. Senior Bianca Boggs continued her assault on the W&M record books as she finished her career with 1,455 points, which ranks xx in school history, while her single-season 530 points was a new school record. For her efforts she was named to the All-CAA First-Team for the second straight season. Swanson also guided freshman Eva Hodgson to CAA Rookie of the Year honors, making her the second player in his time at W&M to win the award. Hodgson finished the season averaging 10.2 points and 3.0 assists per contest. The senior class - Boggs, Misha Jones, and Chandler Smith - tied the school record for winningest senior class with 66 victories.

The success continued for the Tribe during the 2017-18 season. W&M won 16 games, which is tied for the fourth most in school history, and posted its second straight winning season for the first time since 2005-06 and 2006-07. His first recruiting class became the winningest class in school history with the team's victory over College of Charleston on Jan. 26. The seniors went onto win 66 games during their four year career. The Tribe raced out to an 11-2 start for the third straight season, which equaled the best 13-game start in school history, and led the CAA in blocked shots (218) and blocked shots per game (7.3), which ranked fourth and third in the NCAA, respectively. Both numbers are single-season school records. Individually, he mentored three players to five All-CAA awards, including All-CAA First-Team selection Bianca Boggs, who became the first Tribe player in a decade to be named to the league's first-team. Additionally, Boggs was named to the league's all-defensive team, while Abby Rendle claimed a spot on the All-CAA Third-Team, and All-Defensive Team, and freshman Nyla Pollard was picked to the CAA All-Rookie team.

Swanson led the Tribe to one of its best seasons in program history in 2016-17. The Tribe tied a school record with 20 wins, while winning a CAA Tournament game for the first time since 2009, and advancing to the CAA Semifinals for the first-time since 2001. Under his leadership, the Tribe won 11-straight games, which is the longest single-season streak in school history, from Nov. 18, 2016-Jan. 2, 2017. W&M had four players claim seven all-conference awards this season, including seniors Alexandra Masaquel and Marlena Tremba, who each earned second-team citations. Additionally, Masaquel was tabbed the Richmond Times-Dispatch All-State Second-Team, while Tremba earned VaSID All-State Second-Team honors. For his efforts, VaSID honored him as the Virginia State Coach of the Year.

Once again Swanson's third season was one for the record books. The Tribe raced out to its best start in school history with an 11-2 record. W&M went onto again to win the fourth most wins in school history with 15. For the second straight season the Tribe broke the blocks and assist record, by tying the single season assist record (466) and broke the school record for blocks with 148. During the season junior Marlena Tremba became the 15th player in school history to break the 1000-point barrier. Individually, four players earned All-CAA awards as junior Alexandra Masaquel was tabbed to the second-team and all-defensive team, Tremba earned third-team honors, and freshman Bianca Boggs picked up a spot on the all-rookie team. The Tribe was also rewarded for its hard work in the classroom as Masaquel, Tremba, and sophomore Jenna Green earned all-academic team honors.

Swanson's second year with the Green and Gold was one for the record books. The Tribe racked up 15 wins, the fourth-most in school history, on its way to its first-ever postseason appearances with bid in the Women's Basketball Invitational. The Green and Gold had a seven-win turnaround, while setting three school records for assists (466), blocked shots, (143), blocked shots per game (4.5). Individually he helped lead four players to five All-CAA awards. Sophomore Marlena Tremba was named to the All-CAA Third-Team, senior Jazmen Boone was named to the All-Defensive Team, freshman Abby Rendle to the All-Rookie and All-Defensive team, and senior Kyla Kerstetter earned all-academic honors.

In his first season with the Tribe, Swanson led a young team to eight victories in a seven-seed in the CAA Tournament. The Green and Gold finished in the top 10 nationally in steals per game, while Jazmen Boone also ranked in the top 20 in the NCAA in the same category. Under his



guidance Kaitlyn Mathieu garnered Third-Team All-Colonial Athletic Association honors, and went on to sign a professional contract with a team in Germany. In addition, guard Marlena Tremba went onto win CAA Rookie of the Year, and was named to the all-rookie squad. Boone was named to the all-defensive team, while she and Kyla Kerstetter took home all-academic honors.

Swanson oversaw Sacred Heart's transition from Division II to Division I in 1999-00, and the program took off under his direction. Over Sacred Heart's 14 years in Division I, Swanson led SHU to a 280-145 record (.664), including a 190-62 (.754) record in the NEC. He departed as the NEC's all-time winningest head coach with all of his SHU teams finishing third or higher in the league standings. Swanson-lead teams have posted 13 straight winning seasons and 12 straight campaigns with 18 or more victories, including six with 20 or more wins. In 2009, he was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame.

In total, Swanson-coached players earned 19 All-NEC honors, including nine first-team awards, nine NEC All-Tournament Team honors, eight NEC All-Rookie Team selections, four NEC Rookies of the Year, three NEC Tournament MVPs and three NEC Players of the Year.

His teams have also enjoyed success in the classroom. On five occasions, the Pioneers were selected to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll, which has recognized outstanding academic performances from the top teams in each of the five collegiate divisions since 1995-96. On eight occasions since 2003, one of his players was a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection and two Pioneer players were named NEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

In 2012-13, Swanson led Sacred Heart to its third straight postseason appearance, and in the process, recorded his 400th career victory. His milestone win came on Feb. 12, 2013 as the Pioneers defeated Fairleigh Dickinson. SHU completed the season at 22-11, finishing second in the NEC with a 13-5 ledger and garnering a berth in the program's first Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT).

Sacred Heart claimed its third NEC Championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2011-12. The Pioneers also ranked 23rd nationally in the WBCA Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll with a team GPA of 3.35. SHU compiled a season mark to 25-8, winning both the regular season and postseason crowns in the league as Swanson was named NEC Coach of the Year for the fourth time.

The Pioneers earned a berth in the 2011 Women's Basketball Invitational and finished the year at 18-13 with a 12-6 mark in the NEC. After a 0-5 start to the 2008-09 season, Swanson's Pioneers reeled off a 21-game winning streak, the longest in school history and second longest in the country, before finishing with 25-8 record. SHU completed the NEC regular season with a perfect 18-0 mark, becoming just the third team in the history of the conference to accomplish the feat. Swanson earned NEC Coach of the Year honors as Sacred Heart finished off an amazing season by capturing its second league title and trip to the NCAA Tournament over a four-year span. During the 2008-09 season, Swanson moved past former Mount St. Mary's head coach Bill Sheahan (124) as all-time leader in Northeast Conference wins and eclipsing the 300-win plateau in his career.

The 2005-06 season saw Swanson lead the Sacred Heart program to its first NCAA Tournament, capturing the NEC Championship in just its seventh season at the Division I level. Swanson guided the Pioneers to a school record 26-5 record, including a 16-2 NEC ledger. He also garnered career victory No. 250 during the season.

Under his leadership, Sacred Heart was one of the toughest teams on its home court, the William H. Pitt Center, which opened in 1997. During the Pitt Center's opening 16 seasons, Swanson's teams won 81.9 percent (185-41) of its home games. In 2011-12, SHU went 15-1 at home, a season bested only by a perfect 15-0 in 2005-06 and 14-0 in 2003-04. During the stretch, the Pioneers' home winning percentage at the Pitt Center ranked among the best nationally.

After directing the Pioneers to a 20-7 record – the program's first 20-win season – in 1995-96, Swanson was voted Coach of the Year in the New England Collegiate Conference (NECC) and the Women's Basketball

Swanson took the reins of the Sacred Heart University women's basketball program in 1990 and built the Pioneers into one of the top teams in the Northeast. He joined Dave Bike's men's basketball coaching staff at SHU in 1989, and, after becoming head coach of the Pioneer women's program in 1990, did double duty for three seasons before becoming the University's first full-time women's coach in 1993. Prior to Swanson's arrival, the Sacred Heart women's team compiled a 4-21 record. Under his guidance, the climb to Division II respectability was accomplished within three seasons, from 8-19 to 11-16 and, in 1992-93, to 16-13 – the program's first winning record in 11 seasons.

In his time at SHU, he was a four-time NEC Coach of the Year, led Sacred Heart to five postseason bids, including three NCAA Tournament appearances. Swanson guided the Pioneers to four NEC regular season crowns and three NEC tournament championships. SHU posted 20-win seasons seven times during his tenure, including five of the last eight years.
